

WORKSHOP

March 18, 1986

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida, met in a workshop on March 18, 1986, at 9:30 A.M.

The following Board Members were present: Chairman W. F. Miles, Vice-Chairman Raymond Hall, Commissioner Sam Pridgen, Commissioner Joe Griffin, and Commissioner Derward Owens. The Board's Attorney, George R. Miller, was also present at the meeting.

Chairman Miles called the meeting to order.

Mr. Dewey Wilson, Administrative Supervisor, advised the Board that in the near future the State regulations will require that the cells at the landfill be lined and covered with clay. Mr. Wilson stated that this will cost the County approximately \$300,000 per year. The Board discussed a landfill tipping fee.

Mr. Bill Gregory, Waste Management, was present at the meeting and indicated that his company would be interested in purchasing the landfill, the county equipment, and to operate the same. Mr. Gregory will return to the Board Meeting on April 8, 1986, to further discuss the landfill operation.

The Board discussed the need for load limits on county roads.

Commissioner Griffin, Commissioner Hall, and Mr. Wilson will attend the Federal Deficit and Tax Reform: The Impact on Florida Meeting in Tallahassee on April 10 and 11, 1986.
