

WORKSHOP

MARCH 19, 1997

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida, attended a Workshop sponsored by the South Walton Tourist Development Council Board on Wednesday, March 19, 1997 at 10:00 a.m., in the South Walton Tourist Development Council meeting room in Santa Rosa Beach, Florida.

The following Board members were present: Chairman William A. Young, Vice-Chairman Van Ness Butler, Jr., Commissioner Randall Infinger and Commissioner Gordon Porter. Commissioner Joel Paul, Jr. was absent. The Board's Administrative Supervisor, Ronnie Bell, and the Clerk of Court, Dan Bodiford, were also present.

Malcolm Patterson, Executive Director of the South Walton Tourist Development Council, opened the Workshop by introducing the consulting team working on the construction of the South Walton TDC Information Center/Office.

Joe Petrich, Planner with Genesis, presented the drawings and plans of the new SWTDC Information Center/Office and gave a brief background of the design for the proposed 9000 square foot building to be located at the corner of Highway 331 and 98.

Carol Pendleton, with Pendleton and Associates Architects, presented the blue prints of the proposed building.

Victor Bowman, with Pendleton and Associates, presented the cost estimates of the proposed building. The projected total project cost is approximately \$1,358,608.

Don McQuade, Chairman of the SWTDC, introduced the TDC Board members which were present: JoAnn Saucier, Doug Chism, Van Ness Butler, Sarah Cunningham, Jim Vanzandt and Jim Taylor. Jim Rester and Pat Potter were absent.

Chairman Young and other Commissioners voiced their delightment with the proposed building plans and the way in which the SWTDC Board and the consulting team worked to accomplish such a great task with such enthusiasm.

There being no further business, the Workshop was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
