

WORKSHOP

April 15, 1985

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida, met in a Workshop on April 15, 1985, at 9:00 A.M.

The following Board Members were present: Chairman W. F. Miles, Commissioner Sam Pridgen, Commissioner Joe Griffin, and Commissioner Derward Owens. Vice-Chairman Raymond Hall was not present at the meeting.

Chairman Miles called the Workshop to order.

Mr. Lynn Drury, Architect, appeared before the Board to present the plans on the administrative offices. The Board discussed having the building to front on Sixth Street. The Board also discussed the possibility of leaving the brick house located on the site of the proposed jail complex. It was agreed that Mr. Drury's plans would remain as drawn, leaving the administrative building facing north and remove the brick house to create more parking.

Commissioner Griffin presented a personnel plan to the Board for study.

Mr. Cecil Haney, resident of Steel Field, appeared before the Board and advised that if the Board charges a fee to cross the ferry he will file a law suit. Mr. Haney's sister, Mrs. Ettie Mae Evans, stated that she does not feel that it is a justifiable cost for relatives of Bunker Hill residents to be charged. Mr. Haney stated that the ferry operator refused to transport a relative across due to the fact that he had a German tag on the car. No action was taken.
