

WORKSHOP

JUNE 13, 1994

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida met in a regular Workshop session on Monday, June 13, 1994, at 8:30 A.M., in the Commission Boardroom of the Walton County Courthouse.

The following Board members were present: Chairman Gordon Porter, Vice-Chairman Sam Pridgen, Commissioner Charles C. Harris, and Commissioner Johnnie Moore. Commissioner Rosier E. Cuchens, Jr. and Mr. Ronnie E. Bell, Administrative Supervisor to the Board, were absent due to attending a meeting out of town.

Chairman Porter called the Workshop to order.

The Board agreed to place Bruce Ward's recommendation to hire Heather Seigler as full-time 4-H Agent on the consent agenda.

The Board agreed to set a Public Hearing for July 28, 1994, at 5:30 P.M., to consider a land designation change as requested by Steve and Johnnie Maleszewski. This item will be placed on the consent agenda.

Shirl Williams, Assistant Administrative Supervisor, advised the Board that the selling price for the Americana Building is \$95,000.00. The Board can lease the building for \$850.00 per month for a period of two years, after the two years, one half of the amount paid for the lease can be applied to the purchase price.

Bobby Ammons, Assistant Public Works Director, advised the Board that Paul Dickey, District 5 employee, has been working at the Landfill for approximately two months on a part-time basis. Mr. Ammons stated that Commissioner Cuchens requested assistance from the other Commissioners to allow an employee from each district to rotate working two days a week for a period of two weeks to help at the Landfill. The Board suggested to transfer an employee from County Wide to work full-time at the Landfill. The Board directed Mr. Ammons to find out how many men working County Wide has a CDL license. The Board discussed extending the hours at the landfill and utilizing only the new truck.

Mr. Ammons advised the Board that when a county dumpster is placed at a burned house location, the dumpsters are usually over loaded. The Board agreed to require an insurance search be done before a dumpster is placed at

a burned house location. The Board discussed placing dumpsters at burned sites if the individuals are classified as indigent.

The Board agreed to approve a 35¢ raise for Betty Miller, Landfill employee, a 25¢ raise for James Pryor, District 1 employee, and to raise Charlotte Matthews' salary to \$5.00 per hour. These items will be placed on the consent agenda.

The Board agreed to increase the mileage allowance to 26¢ per mile as set by the Legislature, beginning October 1, 1994. This item will be placed on the consent agenda.

The Board agreed to meet on Wednesday, June 22, 1994, at 2:00 P.M. on Lake Shore Drive to view Mr. Kazermaier's property.

Commissioner Harris inquired as to what equipment will be placed in the County Auction on Saturday, June 18, 1994.

The Board agreed to accept the low bid of \$125,297.50 from Okaloosa Asphalt for the paving of Rock Hill Road located in District 1, Bid number 94-110. This item will be placed on the consent agenda.

Mr. Ammons advised the Board that a good used 450 dozer is need at the Landfill. The Board agreed to allow Mr. Ammons to collect prices.

The Board agreed to formally approve a Fireworks Permit for Sandestin to hold a fireworks display on June 10, 1994. All requirements have been met. This item will be placed on the consent agenda.

Chairman Porter advised the Board of a contract for the forty acres above and adjacent to the Walton County Correctional Institute. Chairman Porter stated that an Annex to the Prison is more likely to be approved rather than a work camp. The Board directed Chairman Porter to pursue the contract.

There being no further business, Chairman Porter adjourned the Workshop.
