

BUDGET WORKSHOP

JULY 7, 1992

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida, met in a Budget Workshop on Tuesday, July 7, 1992 at 8:30 A.M., in the County Commission Board room of the Walton County Courthouse.

The following Board members were present: Chairman Sam Pridgen, Commissioner W. F. Miles, and Commissioner Wilson Holley. Vice-Chairman Robert G. Fleet and Commissioner Gordon Porter were absent from the meeting. The Board's Administrative Supervisor was present.

Chairman Pridgen opened the Workshop for discussion.

The present millage rate is 7.2 mils. One mil accounts for 1.3 million dollars of revenue.

The general revenue fund has increased approximately \$600,000.00.

The Board discussed the Library allocation and the Property Appraiser's proposed 1992-93 budget.

The retirement rate has increased along with Worker's Compensation Insurance.

The Board agreed to schedule a Budget Workshop for tomorrow, July 8, 1992 at 8:30 A.M., to allow each County Officer to come before the Board to discuss his or her proposed 1992-93 budget.

The Board reviewed the road and bridge fund and directed Mr. Ronnie Hudson, Public Works Director, to review all the county roads in each district and prepare an estimate of the number of roads in each district which needs to be repaired or resurfaced.

Chairman Pridgen adjourned the Workshop.
