

REGULAR WORKSHOP

JULY 13, 1992

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida, met in a Regular Workshop session on Monday, July 13, 1992 at 8:00 A.M., in the Commission Board room of the Walton County Courthouse.

The following Board members were present: Chairman Sam Pridgen, Vice-Chairman Robert G. Fleet, Commissioner W. F. Miles, Commissioner Wilson Holley, and Commissioner Gordon Porter. The Board's Administrative Supervisor, Mr. Ronnie E. Bell, and the County's Attorney, Mr. George R. Miller were also present.

Chairman Pridgen opened the Workshop for discussions.

Glory Brown, Purchasing Agent, advised that she has access to approximately 2500 bails of hay with seed for \$2.00 a bail. The hay can be stored in the old blue building at the County Shop.

Mrs. Shirl Williams, Assistant County Administrator, advised that Mr. Basil Cole is on the agenda for tomorrow's Regular Meeting requesting a junk yard permit.

Mrs. Williams further advised that Beachside Villas, on tomorrow's agenda is not a Planning Commission approved plat. There is no letter of credit and no contract. The plat was never recorded.

Mr. Rick Marcum with the Economic Development Council (EDC), presented the Board with an up-date on the progress of the EDC.

Mr. Eddie Harrison, of Storer Cable, appeared before the Board to answer any questions the Board may have regarding the Storer Cable franchise. Commissioner Miles asked Mr. Harrison if the franchise could be extended to all of Bob Sikes Road. Commissioner Holley asked about the King Lake area.

Mr. Charles McMillian, Courthouse Maintenance Supervisor, presented the Board with an up-date of all the current projects on which he is working.

The Board agreed to budget a salary increase for Mr. McMillian during the 1992-93 budget year.

Mr. Mike Barker, Emergency Management Director, presented the Board with 120 names for roads in Walton County that the Road Naming Committee recommended. Only three road names out of the 120 were not one hundred percent agreed on by the residents residing on those roads. The three names are as follows: Waste Water Treatment Plant Road or

Earl Godwin Road, Tom Garner Road or Spence Drive, and Bishop Lane or Memory Lane.

The Board agreed to leave the decision to the Road Naming Committee.

Ms. Latilda Hughes, County Planner, presented the Board with a list of the findings based on the recommended order to the Administration Commission for the Department of Community Affairs regarding the noncompliance of the comprehensive plan.

The Board discussed raising the tipping fees at the County Landfill.

Chairman Pridgen adjourned the Workshop.
