

WORKSHOP

JULY 27, 1992

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County Florida, met in a regular Workshop session on Monday, July 27, 1992 at 8:00 A.M., in the Commission Board room of the Walton County Courthouse.

The following Board members were present: Chairman Sam Pridgen, Vice-Chairman Robert G. Fleet, Commissioner W. F. Miles, Commissioner Wilson Holley, and Commissioner Gordon Porter. The Board's Administrative Supervisor, Mr. Ronnie E. Bell, was also present.

Chairman Pridgen opened the Workshop for discussions.

Mrs. Shirl Williams, Assistant Administrative Supervisor to the Board, advised that a stop-work order has been issued to the Edgewater Beach development project.

Mr. Frank Shelton of Angelo Benedetty Inc., presented the Board with a brief presentation of the operation of asphalt recycling.

Mr. Steve Macomber, with Blue Cross Blue Shield Insurance Company, presented the Board with an update on the current status of Health Insurance for the Walton County employees. Mr. Macomber reviewed the HMO, Health Maintenance Organization, alternative plan with the Commissioners.

Mr. Bell advised of a letter from the Florida Association of Counties regarding the Suncom telephone system.

Mr. Bell also advised the Commissioners that the House Bill stating that funds shall be allocated as additional grants to Counties for the specific purpose of abating and providing mosquito control relating to waste tire sites.

Glory Brown, Purchasing Agent, advised the Board that Okaloosa County has a hay blower. Ms. Brown asked if the Commissioners were interested in seeing a demonstration.

Ms. Brown further advised of the following two options to be placed on the bid specifications for the excavator and loaders for District 3: repair expense guarantee and maintenance expense guarantee.

Vice-Chairman Fleet advised that the Florida House of Representatives Bill for Affordable Housing passed.

Commissioner Holley directed Mr. Bell to gather information showing the amount of money the County pays for health insurance for County employees from 1988 to the present.

Commissioner Porter advised that Mr. Jerry Lindsey, District 4 employee, is ill and needs additional sick leave.

Commissioner Porter suggested that the Okaloosa Walton Child Care Title XX expenditure of funds program be investigated.

Commissioner Miles advised that he has received several complaints regarding the name of Tom Garner Road.

Chairman Pridgen adjourned the Workshop.
