

SEPTEMBER 03, 1960 - SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida met in a special meeting on Saturday, September 3, 1960 with all Commissioners present together with S.M. Preacher, Attorney to the Board, E. Leo Andrews, Clerk and Carolyn Spikes, Deputy Clerk.

Bids were received by the Board on the Installation of a new heating system for the County Jail as per the Legal Notice published August 18 & 25, 1960 in the DeFuniak Herald, a local newspaper, as follows:

The Board after study of the various bids and two systems proposed, decided to table the acceptance of any bid until a later meeting.

Mr. Ton Fountain, of the Reliable Abstract Company, was present before the Board. He requested that the Board have Mr. Garland Edwards reproduce the original Plat of D.L. Campbell in the Town of DeFuniak for the permanent records of Walton County. Upon motion by Commissioner Thompson, Seconded by Commissioner Bell, the Board voted unanimously to instruct the Clerk to pay up to \$50.00 to have this Plat reproduced and Mr. S.M. Preacher, Attorney for the Board be instructed to take the necessary legal steps to have this plat entered in the official plat records of Walton County as the official plat of said sub-division.

The Clerk having obtained several quotations of prices for a floor machine with buffing-brush and scrub-brush, upon motion of Commissioner Burgess, seconded by Commissioner Rigdon, the Board voted unanimously to direct the Clerk to issue a purchase order to The Taylor Chemical Company of Panama City, Florida, who submitted the low quotation of \$220.00 for a 16" machine.

Upon motion of Commissioner Bell, seconded by Commissioner Burgess, the Board voted unanimously to hold a public hearing on closing a road in District 5 (description to be furnished by Commissioner Gavin) and to close the Pendry Road in District #3, and directed the Clerk to have the notices published when said description had been supplied, as follows:

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting adjourned.
