

WORKSHOP

SEPTEMBER 12, 1986

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida, met in a workshop on September 12, 1986, at 10:00 A.M. to discuss the proposed Farmer's Market.

The following Board members were present. Vice-Chairman Raymond Hall, Commissioner Sam Pridgen, Commissioner Joe Griffin and Commissioner Derward Owens. Chairman Miles was out of town and could not attend.

Vice-Chairman Hall called the informal meeting to order and introduced Mr. Jerry Wyrick, Marketing Specialist for the Department of Agriculture (DOA).

Mr. Wyrick discussed the needs and location necessary to have a productive Farmer's Market. Mr. Wyrick stated that the traffic base and shopping base are large factors to be considered when choosing a location for a Farmer's Market. The Board discussed appointing a Technical Advisory Committee to study the needs and location of the proposed Farmer's Market. The following are members that were recommended: Jerry Wyrick, Edsel Thomaston, Shirley Ward, W. O. Campbell Jr., Joe Dugger and T. C. Campbell. The Board tentatively set a meeting for October 22, 1986, at 7:00 P.M., to be held at the Fair Building for the purpose of the Committee to meet with the farmers who are interested in discussing what crops could be sold at the Farmer's Market.
