

BUDGET HEARING

SEPTEMBER 18, 1989

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida, conducted a Public Hearing on Monday, September 18, 1989, at 6:00 P.M., to consider adopting the 1989-90 budget and millage.

The following Board Members were present: Chairman Sam Pridgen, Vice-Chairman W.F. Miles, and Commissioner Donald D. Brown. Absent from the meeting were Commissioners Wilson Holley and Robert G. Fleet.

Chairman Pridgen called the meeting to order.

Chairman Pridgen advised that the property tax levy has increased by 8.5% and the operating budget expenditures are 10.3% more than last year's operating budget expenditures.

No one was present to object to the budget.

Motion by Vice-Chairman Miles, second by Commissioner Brown, to adopt a resolution setting the 1989-90 millage at 7.450 mills for County operations and .650 for the North Walton Mosquito Control District. Ayes 3, Nays 0. Brown Aye, Miles Aye, Pridgen Aye.

Motion by Vice-Chairman Miles, second by Commissioner Brown, to adopt a resolution setting the 1989-90 budget at \$16,870,032.42 for the County and \$156,851.99 for the North Walton Mosquito Control District Budget. Ayes 3, Nays 0. Brown Aye, Miles Aye, Pridgen Aye.


