

WORKSHOP

September 26, 1983

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida, met in a Workshop on September 26, 1983 at 2:00 P. M., to discuss a study on the sanitation problems in Walton County made by Mr. Mike Alford.

The following Board Members were present: Chairman Derward Owens, Commissioner Sam Pridgen, Commissioner Bob Anderson, and Commissioner W. L. "Billy" McLean. Commissioner W. F. Miles entered the meeting at 2:30 P.M.

Chairman Owens called the meeting to order.

Mr. Mike Alford and Mr. John Dixon presented a copy of the study and a proposal to provide refuse containers at different points in the county to handle the garbage. The containers would then be carried to the Central Landfill.

Mr. Dixon advised the Board of the proposed compactor that is to be build on 20 acres of land that he has purchased on the J. D. Miller Road.

Mr. William Mekvlsky advised the Board that he lives  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile from the proposed site and that he is very opposed to the location. Mr. Mekvlsky also advised that other residents are opposed to the site due to the fact that it will lower the value of their property. Mr. Mekvlsky stated that if the garbage trucks go down the J. D. Miller Road and across Power Line Road to Highway 331 the Board will have to pave the roads.

Mr. Dixon advised that the trucks will enter and exit on the J. D. Miller Road from Highway 98.

Commissioner McLean asked Mr. Dixon if he would be willing to pave the J. D. Miller Road from the proposed site to Highway 98. Mr. Dixon advised that he would be willing to do whatever necessary.

Motion by Commissioner McLean, second by Commissioner Miles, to recess

to allow the Board to go and inspect the site and equipment. Ayes 5, Naves 0. McLean Aye, Anderson Aye, Pridgen Aye, Miles Aye, Owens Aye.
