

BUDGET HEARING FOR FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING

OCTOBER 15, 1979

The Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida, met in an advertised Budget Hearing October 15, 1979 at 9:00 A.M.

The following Board members were present: Chairman James Rushing, District 1; Vice-Chairman Derward Owens, District 4; Commissioner Bob Anderson, District 3; Commissioner Freddy Bishop, District 5. Commissioner Lawton Mathews, District 2; was out of town due to illness in his family.

Chairman Rushing called the meeting to order.

Motion by Commissioner Bishop, second by Commissioner Owens, to adopt the Federal Revenue Sharing Budget for 1979-80 as advertised. Ayes 4, Nays 0. Bishop Aye, Anderson Aye, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye. See Supplemental Book 1, Page 1.

Motion by Commissioner Bishop, second by Commissioner Anderson, to adjourn. Ayes 4, Nays 0. Bishop Aye, Anderson Aye, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye.

Chairman Rushing called the Board into Special Session to discuss and act on County emergency matters at 9:10 A.M., October 15, 1979.

The Board discussed the bids on Norwood Road and Juniper Lake Road that were accepted for study on October 9, 1979. Motion by Commissioner by Commissioner Anderson, second by Commissioner Bishop, to award the contract to Okaloosa Asphalt, \$213,555.42, upon approval of the Board's Engineer and the Board's Attorney. Ayes 4, Nays 0. Bishop aye, Anderson Aye, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye.

Motion by Commissioner Anderson, second by Commissioner Bishop, for the engineer to prepare specifications to resurface the Blue Mountain Road from Highway 98 to Blue Mountain Beach, and Sandy Creek Road from the cross roads of Highway 183 and 183A to the Holmes County line. Ayes 4, Nays 0. Bishop Aye, Anderson Aye, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye.

Motion by Commissioner Anderson, second by Commissioner Owens, to instruct Attorney Miller to prepare permits to allow people to cut fire wood from the 40 acres landfill site for home use only, not for resale. Ayes 4, Nays 0. Bishop Aye, Anderson Aye, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye.

Motion by Commissioner Owens, second by Commissioner Bishop, to release to the Sheriff's Department \$8265.00 for the LEAA 77-A2CE01 Communication Grant. Ayes 4, Nays 0. Bishop Aye, Anderson Aye, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye.

Motion by Commissioner Anderson, second by Commissioner Owens, to approve for Monroe Darby to be in charge of gas and diesel for the county wide dozier and dragline. Ayes 4, Nays 0. Bishop Aye, Anderson Aye, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye.

Motion by Commissioner Bishop, second by Commissioner Owens, to stop furnishing driveway permits. Culverts will be ordered to be used for new construction or to replace old culverts. Permits already approved will be honored. Ayes 3, Nays 1. Bishop Aye, Anderson Naye, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye. Commissioners Rushing and Bishop feel that by no longer furnishing pipe, the money can be used to pave more roads.

Motion by Commissioner Bishop, second by Commissioner Owens, to order the following pipe:

20	18" x 24'	pipe
20	24" x 24'	pipe
6	15" x 24"	pipe
2	15"	bands
12	18"	bands
12	24"	bands
3	24" x 24'	pipe coated
2	24"	bands coated

Ayes 3, Naves 1. Bishop Aye, Anderson Naye, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye.

Motion by Commissioner Bishop, second by Commissioner Owens, for each commissioner to requisition the pipe to be used in his district in a regular board meeting. Ayes 3, Naves 1. Bishop Aye, Anderson Naye - feels everyone should obtain a permit, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye.

Motion by Commissioner Owens, second by Commissioner Bishop, to purchase one bundle of 2x8x16' treated lumber for the Chesser Bridge and other bridges in District 4. Ayes 4, Naves 0. Bishop aye, Anderson Aye, Owens Aye, Rushing Aye.

Motion by Commissioner Anderson, second by Commissioner Bishop, to Adjourn. Ayes 4, Naves 0. Bishop Aye, Anderson Aye, Owens aye, Rushing Aye.
