

OCTOBER 27, 1961 - SPECIAL METING

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida met in special session at 10.00 p.m. on October 27, 1961 with the following members present and participating:


Commissioner O.O. Thompson, Chairman; Hubert Bell, Vice Chairman; Kylea Laird; Marvin Rigdon; and Coy Burgess. Also present was E. Leo Andrews, Clerk.


Chairman O.O. Thompson asked if anyone wanted to make any complaints or suggestion of any changes in Tentative Supplementary Budget for Fine and Forfeiture Fund as advertised in The DeFuniak Herald Thursday, October 19, 1961. There being no complaints or suggestion of changes being made, Commissioner Bell moved that this supplementary budget be adopted as same appeared in the legal notice in the DeFuniak Herald. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Laird and on vote carried unanimously.

The Tentative Budgets for Capital Outlay Funds and General Revenue Funds having appeared in legal notices in the October 26, 1961 issue of the DeFuniak Herald, were reviewed and adopted subject to any action that may be taken by the Board regarding any complaints or suggested changes that may be received on or before November 3, 1961 as advertised in the DeFuniak Herald; the Board being scheduled for a meeting at 10 o'clock a.m. November 3, 1961 to hear any complaints or suggestions.

Copies of these supplementary budgets appear on pages 545 and 546, Incorporated in the Minutes of the meeting of the Board on October 10. 1961.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
