

Monday, January 26th, 1925.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, meet in Special Session on this Monday, January 26th, 1925, with the following members present, G M Bishop, R L Jones, W M Infinger, E B Mitchell and W I Stinson, Chairman.

This meeting was called for the purpose of receiving bids on two road projects and for the purpose of purchasing a Fordson Tractor and other business that might come before it.

The following bids were received and opened and considered,-

Darlington & State Line Road

W. S. McCullough, \$450.00 per mile.
Lorenzo Clark, \$340.00 per mile.
Henry Nowling, Jr. \$309.00 per mile.

Portland & DeFuniak Road.

B J Infinger, 790.00 per mile

Upon motion made by G M Bishop and duly seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried by unanimous ~~by carried by~~ a vote of all members of this board, it was ordered that the bid of Henry Nowling, Jr. for \$309.00 per mile be accepted for building the Darlington and State Line road, providing he enter into a good and sufficient bond in the sum of \$750.00, with two or more good and sufficient sureties, and it was agreed between the bidder and the Board that he be allowed Four months within which to complete the work.

Upon motion made by G M Bishop and duly seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members of this board, it was ordered that the bid of F A Strickland for \$337.50 per mile be accepted for building the Portland and DeFuniak Springs road, providing he enter into a good and sufficient bond in the sum of \$500.00 with two or more good and sufficient sureties.

Upon motion made by R L Jones and duly seconded by G M Bishop and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members of this board, it was ordered that the bid of Hughes Brothers for \$572.00 for the Fordson Tractor be accepted.

The Notary Public bond of John A McDonald with F A Florence and Jno D King, as sureties was approved.

Mr Lee Turner of Paxton and Mr Tompse Manning of Florala, was before the board in regard to getting this Board to help defray one half of the expenses of fencing this County and Covington County, Ala. and filed a petition signed by various and sundry persons asking for this to be done. The Board agreed to take this under advisement for the time being.

Upon motion made by Commissioner R L Jones and duly seconded by Commissioner G M Bishop, and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members of this Board, the following Resolution was ordered adopted,-

RESOLUTION.

State of Florida, AT A MEETING OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AT DEFUNIAK SPRINGS,
Walton County. FLORIDA, January 26, 1925.

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama has established and constructed a state high-
way leading from Montgomery, Alabama, to Florala, Alabama, near the Florida state line, and

WHEREAS, that Alabama State Highway Commission has, by resolution, agreed
to extend this project, No. 128, commencing at the intersection of Fifty Avenue and Third
Street, of Florala, Alabama, thence southerly along said Third Street to the Florida and
Alabama state line, upon condition that the State of Florida and the county authorities of
Walton County agree to join with the State of Alabama at this point.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved, by the County Commissioners of Walton County
Florida, in session at DeFuniak Springs, Fla. on January 26, 1925.

That, we agree to join with the State of Alabama, at said point, viz.,
where Third Street of the City of Florala, Alabama, intersects the Florida and Alabama State
line, and we do hereby officially declare and designate this point as the official physical
meeting point of a road connecting Florida Road #33 from Crestview, Florida, to the Alabama
State line at Florala, Alabama, and Alabama Project, No. FAP 128.

There being no further business before the board at this time, we adjourned
to meet in term.
