

Lee Tucker, Lee Tucker, Lee Tuc. Sr, Mrs J F Houseman, S A Wesley, John Carter, W T Bludworth Ernest Adoo, be and the same was rejected, for reasons that the Sheriff having stated at a former meeting of this board that the parties prosecuted for doing business without licenses, were not locked up in the county jail.

The Board then adjourned to meet again Thursday, April 16th, 1925 to transact any further business which might come to their attention.

THURSDAY, April 16th, 1925.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, meet on this April 16th, 1925, pursuant to adjournment of April 14th, 1925, with the following members present, W M Infinger, E B Mitchell, G M Bishop, P L Jones, and W I Stinson, Chairman.

The Board authorized Chairman, W I Stinson, to ask the town council of DeFuniak Springs, to employ W F Jones, Tax Collector, to figure up and submit the County a statement of what the county owes the town on 1/2 of the Road & Bridge tax collected by the county on the 1924 assessment roll, and the county would make a settlement as heretofore.

E B Mitchell, deposited with the Clerk \$5.00, Road Tax from Dist. #5.

✓ Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered that C D Thompson be appointed Overseer on road from State line to Darlington and from Darlington to Holmes County line, on Darlington and Samson Road and Darlington and Westville road, for the year 1925, or until his successor is appointed and qualified.

✓ Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered the former order of this board appointing Earley Wilson as Road Overseer on road designated be rescinded, and it was further ordered that Jack Grice, be appointed in his place.

✓ Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered that the former order of this board appointing J G Godwin as Road Overseer on road therein designated be rescinded, and it was further ordered that J. Grieger, be appointed in his place.

✓ Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered that N W Broxson be appointed as Road Overseer on road No. 10, known as Ponce de Leon and Bullard's Still road.

✓ Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered that Mac Hamilton, be appointed as Road Overseer from Bay Branch to District line on Freeport Road.

✓ Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered that the former order of this board appointing Will King be rescinded, and it was further ordered that Bennie King be appointed as Road Overseer on road designated in his place. (From Portland to County line known as Portland and Rockey or County line road.)

✓ Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered that the former order of this board appointing Lewis Smith as Road Overseer, be rescinded, and further ordered that T L Wells be appointed Overseer in his place.

✓ Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered that Glenn Moore, be appointed as Road Overseer from Holmes County line to District line near Bill Miles' place by way of Darlington, road known as Darlington road.

Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered that former order of this board appointing D Lock as Road Overseer on road designated be rescinded.

✓ Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered that Willie B Parker, be appointed as Road Overseer on road from Bishop Creek to Live Oak Creek on Boggy road, road known as the Boggy road.

✓ Upon motion made and duly carried, it was ordered that F A Strickland, be appointed as Road Overseer on road leading from New Home road to Bishop Creek, road known as Boggy road.

Upon motion made and duly carried it was ordered that the former order of this appointing El Bishop, as Road Overseer on roads therein designated be rescinded and it was further ordered that M L Butler be appointed as Road Overseer in his place.

Upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by E B Mitchell and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the Chairman, W I Stinson, be and he is hereby authorized to make Dr E L Townsend an offer of \$150.00 for a clay pit, being the land not now fenced, and a portion now being used as a clay pit, being about 65/100 acres, and to inform E L Townsend that if this offer is refused to expect condemnation proceedings.

As per agreement of the 14th, the Board went in a body to inspect the Right-of-way thru Mr P Permenter's land in Sec.34-2N-19, and also two other rights-of-way leading from New Home Still to the widow Ballie Cosson place, and the other route by B J Infinger's place, and after a thorough inspection returned to the Court House.

Upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger, and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that all former orders or resolutions of this board effecting the creating and discontinuing Public Roads be rescinded on account of an emergency at this particular time.

Upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by R L Jones, and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the road leading thru NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.34 Tp 2 N R 19 W, or 160 acres that P Permenter now owns, be and it is hereby discontinued as a public road, providing P Permenter will give Walton County a right-of-way thirty (30) ft wide beginning on West side of said 160 acres, where the present road now runs, thence running North to North west corner of said 160 acres, thence due East on section line to Northeast corner of said Section, thence due South on said Section to the present New Home and DeFuniak Springs public road, with a further provision that he the said P Permenter will clear the right of way.

Upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by E B Mitchell, and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the road beginning at or near the New Home School House & Church house in Sec.1-1N-19, and run in a Northerly direction as near as practical and feasible on road right of way to where it intersects the Freeport & Milton road near the widow Ballie Cosson's place be designated as the connecting road between present County road system and Forrest project to Valparaiso, Fla.

The Clerk was requested to write Mr G B Anchors the actions of this Board and to advise Mr Anchors to write to Commissioner W M Infinger in regard to his wishes.

The Clerk was requested to write to Mr P Permenter of the actions of this board in regard to the road passing thru his place.

The Clerk was authorized to purchase two deed records for the use of Walton County.

The Clerk was authorized to purchase Ice for the use of the Court House during the Summer.

The Board agreed to hold its next regular meeting on Tuesday, May 5th, 1925, on account of the Spring Term of the Circuit Court, and to give notice of same in both of the County News-Papers.

The Board agreed not to take any official actions on W H Wesley, Jr. request in regard to the changing of the Freeport and Ft. Washington Ferry until they obtain legal information from the County Attorney.

The following bills against the County were then considered and being found correct and legally due, upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger, and duly carried by unanimous vote, were ordered paid and warrants drawn therefor as follows,*
