

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, meet on this Monday, June 1st, A D 1925, as required by law with the following members present, E B Mitchell, W M Infinger, G M Bishop, R L Jones and W I Stinson, Chairman.

E B Mitchell deposited with the Clerk of this Board \$6.00 road tax from Dist. #5.

Upon motion made by Commissioner G M Bishop, seconded by Commissioner E B Mitchell the following resolution as unanimously adopted,-

Whereas Section 4 Chapter 8584, Acts of 1921 provides that the County Commissioners shall meet on the first Monday in June of each year, with the County Assessor of Taxes at Clerk's office for the purpose of hearing complaints and receiving testimony as to values of real and personal property as assessed by the County Assessor of Taxes, and

Whereas the County Assessor of taxes this day advises the said Board of County Commissioners that the Assessment Roll is not ready for comparing values & etc.,

Therefore be it Resolved that this meeting be continued until the first Monday in July A D 1925, being July 6th, 1925, and Notice be published as required by law of such meeting.

Notary Public bond of E H Miller, \$500.00 approved with American Surety Co. of New York as surety.

There being no further business before the Board at this time, they adjourned to meet in term.

It might appear to you gentlemen that the amount asked for is too much.
