The Board of County Commissioners of alton County, Florida, meet onthis Tues- day, July 14th, A D 1925, pursuant to a recess of July 13th, 1925, with the following members present, R L Jones, E B Mitchell, G M Bishop, W I Stinson, Chairman, and W M Infinger.

Upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by R L Jones, the Minutes of the previous meeting held during June and July, 1925, was read and ordered approved by unanimous vote.

E B Mitchell deposited \$5.00 with Clerk, road tax from Dist. #5.

W F Jones, Tax Collector, filed his June 30th, 1925, report of Licenses collected showing \$78.00 for State and \$39.00 for Walton County collected.

W F Jones, Tax Collector, filed his June 30th, 1925, report of Polls collected showing \$116.00 collected.

Notary Public Bond of S K Gillis, \$500.00 was approved with M T King and James A McLean, as sureties.

Mr Luvenc of Steiner Bros. Birmingham, Ala. was before the Board in regard to the issuance of \$150,000.00 Bonds for the purpose of building and equipping a County Court house, various plans & etc were discussed pro and con .

Upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by R L Jones and duly carried by unani- mous vote, it was ordered that the Board of County Commissioners employ D. Stuart Gillis, to represent the County's interest in the two suits wherein Chas E Gessna and The Fidelity Co. is plaintiff and M T Fountain as Clerk of the Circuit Court, Ernest Amos, State Comptr. and A M Everett, defendants, the suits involving the validity of tax sale certificates, his fees or salary to be 3% of the amount gained in the suit or a minum fee of \$350.00
