


Wednesday August 12, 1925.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in Special Session on this August 12, 1925, by call of its Chairman, with the following members present, E B Mitchell, G M Bishop and W I Stinson, Chairman.

This meeting was called for the purpose of disposing of the request of Mr John Davis, for permission to change the road by his place, on the DeFuniak Springs and Euchanna road, this request was considered and a quorum of the board went and inspected same and upon motion of E B Mitchell, seconded by G M Bishop, and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, it was ordered that this request of Mr Davis be refused for reasons, 1st. Present road has cost considerable money to construct and is on high ground and in fair condition, 2nd That proposed road as opened by Mr Davis is on low marshy ground and in poor condition and the cost of constructing a road on ground would be high and road would be hard to maintain, 3rd. Board believes it will be a disadvantage to the general public and unnecessary expense to the tax payers to grant the proposed change, and Clerk was directed to notify Mr Davis his request was refused.

There being no further business before the board, adjourned to meet in ~~next~~ Special Session on Sept. 2nd, 1925.
