

Monday, October 5th, 1925.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this Monday October 5th, A D 1925, as provided by law and pursuant to a recess of September 30th, 1925, with the following Members present and participating, E B Mitchell, G M Bishop and W I Stinson, Chairman, and the following proceedings were had and done.

The Chairman advised the other Members that this meeting was held in compliance with the Law in regard to the Board meeting on the first Monday in October of each year for the purpose of accepting the other two books of the Assessment roll, and the Tax Assessor S M Preacher appeared and advised that the Assessment roll were not completed as yet and the Board being unable to comply with the Law in such cases made and provided, thereupon Commissioner G M Bishop offered the following resolution which was duly seconded by Commissioner E B Mitchell and carried by unanimous vote of all members present.

Whereas Section 728, Revised General Statutes of Florida, 1920, provides that the "County Assessor of taxes shall make out two fair copies of the assessment roll when thus completed, and shall annex to the original and each copy ~~of~~ the affidavit in Section 722, which copies, with the original, he shall turn over to the board of county commissioners at a meeting to be held on the first Monday in October of each and every year for that purpose, at which meeting the county commissioners shall examine and compare such original and two copies and cause the county assessor of taxes, who shall attend such meeting from day to day, to correct all mistakes and inaccuracies in description and other character, and after such books shall have been examined and corrected, the board of county commissioners shall indorse on them a certificate that they have so examined them and that they are correct, & etc etc", and

Whereas, the County Assessor of taxes advises the board that the copies of the assessment roll is not ready for their inspection & etc.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, take a recess until October 20th, A D 1925, for the purpose of giving the County Assessor of taxes more time within which to complete the said copies.

There being no further business before the board at this time, the board took a recess until Tuesday, October 7th, 1925.

On the 7th day of October, A D 1925, at 2 o'clock P.M. The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in Special Session, due notice of said meeting having been given by publications in the DeFuniak Herald, and in the Bond Buyer, at its County Court House in DeFuniak Springs, Florida, and pursuant also to call of its Chairman, W. I. Stinson, for the purpose of receiving bids for the \$150,000.00 bond issue for building and equipping and furnishing a Court House for said County, and for improving the Court House grounds, at which meeting being duly called to order by its Chairman, the following members of said Board were present and participated, to-wit: W. M. Infinger, R L Jones, E B Mitchell, G M Bishop, W I Stinson, Chairman and M. T. Fountain, Clerk. Being all of the members of said Board.
