The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this October 31st, A D 1925. pursuant to a recess of October 5th, 20th, 1925, with the following Members present, E B Mitchell, W M Infinger and W I Stinson, Chairman.

The board having met for the purpose of comparing and accepting the County Assessor of Taxes assessment roll for the year 1925, and the board having examined same as much as possible owing to the limited time, upon motion of E B Mitchell and seconded by W M Infinger, and duly carried by unanimous vote of the members present, ordered the assessment roll to be accepted and noted the difference in the total amount now and when the board was advised of the total amount prior to making up their 1925-1926 budget.

To Hon. W. F. Jones, Tax collector for the County of Walton.

You are hereby commanded to collect out of the real estate and personal property, and from each of the persons and corporations named in the annexed roll, the taxes set down in each roll opposite each name, corporation or parcel of land therein described, and in case taxes so imposed are not paid at the time prescribed by law, you are to collect the same by levy and sale of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements so assessed, or of the person or corporation so taxed; and all sums collected for the State taxes you are to pay to the State Treasurer at such time as may be required by law, and at the same time you are to pay to the legally qualified Depository all sums collected for county taxes, district school taxes and other special taxes; and you are further required to make all collections on or before the first Monday in April; and on or before the first Monday in July you will make a final report to and settlement with the Comptroller and County Commissioners.

The following Resolution was offered by Mr E B Mitchell and duly seconded by Mr W M Infinger and duly passed by unanimous affirmative vote.

Whereas, The Board of County Commissioners was authorized by a Special Act of the Legislature of 1925 to issue \$150,000.00 five and one half (5½%) per cent, interest payable semi-annually thirteen and a quarter years average Bonds for building and constructing Court House and furnishing same and improving Court House grounds, and,

Whereas Hon. Wm. W. Flournoy, Attorney, of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, by contract engaged to prepare the legal proceedings leading up to and evidencing the legality of issue, including furnishing blank bonds with coupons.

Now Therefore be it Resolved by Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida that the said Wm. W Flournoy, Attorney, promptly and thoroughly prepared transcript of record of proceedings of Board of County Commissioners and transmitted the said <sup>Chas.</sup> to Hon. B. Wood, Attorney, Chicago, Ill. who immediately approved the validity of said Bond issue, and he did also fully advertise the sale of said bonds which was sold on Oct. 7th, 1925 at the good price of 104.65, and,

That Therefore this Board hereby expresses its approval and appreciation for the efficient accurate and prompt service rendered to this Board pursuant to his contract in connection with said bond issue.

Adopted in open session this the 31st day of October, A D 1925.

There being no further business before the board they adjourned to meet in regular session on November 10th, 1925.
