

SPECIAL MEETING HELD AT DEFUNIAK SPRINGS?, FLA.

December 11th, 1925.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in Special Session at the Court House in the town of DeFuniak Springs, Fla. on this December 11th, 1925, pursuant to a call of the Chairman, with the following members present and participating, E B Mitchell, W M Infinger, and W I Stinson, Chairman, together with the following Members of the Advisory Board.,- W L Cawthon and E H Reese.

The meeting was called for the purpose of accepting the plans of the new Court House and advertising for Bids.

Mr Yonge, associate Architect with Warren-Knight & Davis, presented the plans and after considerable discussion pro and con with the agreement with Mr Yonge to make a few minor changes or additions thereto the board accepted the plans with this understanding.

Upon motion made by W M Infinger, seconded by E B Mitchell, and duly carried, it was ordered that the following Notice be published in the DeFuniak Herald, a newspaper published in Walton County, Fla. as required by law.

Sealed bids will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, up to 12:00 o'clock noon, January 5th, 1926, and publicly opened at 2:00 o'clock P M for the erection complete of the Court House building, as per plans and specifications prepared by Warren, Knight & Davis and Candler C Yonge, associate architects, Room 500, American National Bank Building, Pensacola, Florida, a copy of which is now on file in the office of the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, at DeFuniak Springs, Florida, Bidders may procure a set of these plans and specifications from the architects. A deposit of \$15.00 is required on each set to insure the safe return of said plans.

Each bid must be accompanied with a certified check or a bid bond executed by a Surety Company licensed to do business in the State of Florida, in the sum of \$2500.00, payable to Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, Florida, as a guarantee that within ten days from notice of awarding of contract the successful bidder will enter into a written contract with the ~~the~~ Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, and furnish acceptable surety bond in the amount of fifty per cent of the amount bid conditioned upon the carrying out of said contract. Checks or bid bonds of unsuccessful bidders will be returned. Each bid must be sealed and addressed to W I Stinson, Chairman, Board of County Commissioners, Walton County, DeFuniak Springs, Florida, and shall be marked on the envelope "Walton County Court House Bid," and must be received before 12:00 o'clock noon on the 5th day of January, 1926.

Moved by E B Mitchell, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried, it was ordered that the said D S Sellars be and he is hereby authorized to construct a telephone line from New Home to Freeport road and from New Home to Choctawhatchee Bay along the right of way of the present public road, conditioned that the said D S Sellars agrees to move the poles in case road is increased in width in any time in the future.


The Board then adjourned to meet in Regular Session on January 5th and 6th, 1926,
