

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in Special Session on this Friday, January 22nd, A D 1926, pursuant to call by its Chairman, W I Stinson and after due notice given by publication, for the purpose of discussing a proposed system of County Roads.

There was present at said meeting the following members, to-wit: R L Jones, W M Infinger, G M Bishop and W I Stinson, Chairman.

The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners called the meeting to order and gave a brief outline of the meeting.

Thereupon it was moved and carried and so ordered that Hon. A G Campbell, act as Chairman of said meeting.

After discussing the proposed question of county roads pro and con by various and sundry citizens, upon motion of Judge D Stuart Gillis the same being duly seconded and so ordered that the Chairman of said meeting appoint two or more citizens from each County Commissioner District to meet with the Board of County Commissioners for the purpose of laying out the said system of county roads, at a meeting to be held soon upon call of the Chairman of said Board of County Commissioners.

The Board then retired to the Grand Jury room to discuss some changes in the building of the New County Court House, and after discussing the same pro and con, the Clerk was advised to write to Warren-Knight & Davis and Chandler C Yonge, Architects to proceed with plans and specifications to build the Court House to be fire proof construction.

Mr A B Dawson and associate Mr Ralph Wilson of the Beach-Grove Company presented a map of Magnolia Beach and asked the Board to approve of same, and after examining the same and finding it to comply with the Laws in all respect as far as the Board could ascertain, upon motion of R L Jones, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried, it was ordered that the Map or Plat of Magnolia Beach be approved, and further ordered that the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to approve same for record.

Mr H E Rish, County Commissioner from Gulf County, Fla. was before the Board in regard to purchasing a Convict Cage, and upon motion of R L Jones, seconded by W M Infinger, and duly carried, it was ordered that ^{this Board} would sell the small convict cage on board cars Bearhead, Fla. for \$300.00, one third March 1st, 1/3 April 1st and 1/3 May 1st, 1926.

The Board then adjourned to meet upon call of its Chairman.

WEDNESDAY, January 27th, 1926.

The following advisory committee was present, - S K Miller, E R Ward, J J Ward, E H Reese, Lee Mathis, J L Bell, J A Neel, G W Keene, Calvin Prescott, D S Sellars, Will Kelly and A L Anderson.

There was other interested citizens present at said meeting.

Hon. D. Stuart Gillis, County Attorney, explained the legal details as to petitions, duties & etc.

After considerable discussion pro and con as to where the roads should be built and various and sundry other details in regard to a bond issue the committee proceeded with their duties.

The committee then adjourned to meet again to-morrow Jan. 28th, 1926.
