

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in Regular Session on this Tuesday, March 9th, A D 1926, with the following members present and participating, E B Mitchell, R L Jones, W M Infinger, G M Bishop and W I Stinson, Chairman, and M T Fountain as Clerk.

E B Mitchell deposited with the Clerk \$54.00 road tax from District No.5, collected on the McCallum Bridge and Red Bay road.

Moved by W M Infinger, seconded by E B Mitchell, it was duly ordered that the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to purchase certain office supplies from the Standard Printing Co.

Upon motion made by W M Infinger, seconded by R L Jones and duly carried, it was ordered that the following Road Overseers be appointed until January 1, 1927, or until their successors are appointed and qualified.

Overseer,
Byron W Collins/from the district bounded on the east by the Section line running North and South on the East side of Section 24 Tp 2 S R 20 W, and on the south by the Section line running east and west on the south side of Section 24 Tp 2 S R 20 W and on the west and North by Choctawhatchee Bay.

Herman Weston, Overseer, from the district east of and including the section line running north and south East of sections Section 27 Tp 2 S R 20 W.

Capt. M. T. Grimaldi, Overseer, from the district ~~the district~~ west of the section line running north and south on the east side of Sections 27 and 34 tp 2 S R 20 W.

Perry Holley, Overseer, from Pt. Washington to Bay County line, road known as the Vernon road.

John Kelley, Overseer, from Pt. Washington to Grayton Beach, road known as the Pt. Washington and Grayton Beach road.

Upon requisition of Sheriff, Thad Bell, Moved by R L Jones, seconded by W M Infinger, and duly carried, it was ordered that the Sheriff be authorized to purchase 1 case of Soap and 1 case of Washing powders for use of jail.

Mr A L Anderson, appeared before the board in regard to the condition of the road leaving the Boggy road and running toward the Sconiers Mill Creek, and the Commissioners agreed to look after this road at once.

Notary Public Bond of George W Keen, Jr. \$500.00, was approved with American Surety Company of New York, N Y, as surety

Moved by R L Jones, seconded by E B Mitchell, and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the Chairman and Clerk of this Board be and they are hereby authorized to issue Warrant on the Court House Bond Fund to the First Trust and Savings Bank of Chicago, Ill. for the semi-annual interest due on the \$150,000.00 Court House Bonds on April 1st, 1926, same amounting to \$4125.00, so that the same will be in Chicago, Ill. on due date.

Moved by W M Infinger, Seconded by R L Jones, and duly carried, it was ordered that the Clerk with the assistance of the County Attorney, prepare ballots and have The Breeze Printery print them for the Bond election to be held March 30th, 1926.

Moved by E B Mitchell, seconded by R L Jones, and duly carried, it was ordered that Mrs L. McCall, Red Bay, Fla. be placed upon the paupers list at \$3.00 per month until further order of this Board.
