

MAY 21ST, 1926.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this May 21st, A D 1926, pursuant to adjournment of May 4th, 1926, with the following members present and participating, W M Infinger, G M Bishop and W I Stinson, Chairman, and M T Fountain, Clerk of said Board.

Upon motion made by Commissioner B. M. Bishop seconded by Commissioner W. M. Infinger and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, the following resolution was ordered adopted, -

Whereas, Walton County, Florida, issued \$150,000.00 worth of bonds for the purpose of building a Court House & etc., and

Whereas, the money derived from the sale of said Bonds were deposited in the Cawthon State Bank and the First National Bank of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, and the said banks were required to give a surety bond or deposit securities with the State Comptroller in the amount of \$75,000.00 each, and

Whereas, the said Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida has drawn checks or warrants against the said funds in said banks, leaving a balance in the Cawthon State Bank of \$51,587.53 and a balance in the First National Bank of \$60,000.27.

Therefore be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Fla., that the State Comptroller of the State of Florida, be and he is hereby authorized to release or reduce the bonds of each bank to a sufficient amount to cover the above balances.

Moved by G M Bishop, seconded by M Infinger, that the list of Managers and Clerks of the General Primary Election to be held June 8th, 1926, be revised by removing the name of Renald Holley and substituting the name of Glenn Bludworth, in Precinct No. 15, Point Washington.

W F Jones, Tax Collector, was authorized to exchange his old typewriter for a new one and the county to pay the difference in price of same.

Moved by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger and ordered that S M Mitchell be advanced the sum of \$500.00 on contract in building road from New Home School house to

May 21st, 1926.
