

SPECIAL MEETING, MONDAY OCTOBER 25th, 1926.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Fla. met in Special Session on this Oct. 25th, 1926, pursuant to a call of its Chairman, W I Stinson, for the purpose of considering plans and specifications for seating & etc for New Court House and other changes

be brought to the attention of said Board, with the following members present and participating, W M Infinger, G M Bishop and W I Stinson, Chairman.

Mr Chandler C Yonge, Associate Architect, discussed the advisability of converting the store room on third floor in new court house into a Grand Jury room, and he was instructed to proceed with plans and specifications to be approved by this board at a latter meeting to be held by this Board, and he was further requested to proceed to Birmingham, Ala. at once, at the expense of Walton County, and take this matter up with Warren-Knight & Davis Architects, and get seating plans, Judge's stand & etc prepared as soon as possible so that bids could be asked for on Nov. 19th, 1926.

Moved by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried, ordered that due notice be given that the Board of County Commissioners would receive sealed bids until 10 o'clock A M November 19th, 1926, for the purpose of purchasing of seating, floor cover, Judge's stand & etc for the use of the New Court House, the board to reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

The Board then adjourned until October 30th, 1926.
