

WEDNESDAY, June 15th, A.D. 1927

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met at 5 o'clock P. M. on this June 15th, A. D. 1927, at the Court House in the Town of DeFuniak Springs, Fla., with the following members present and participating, Mr. W. I. Stinson, Chairman, Mr. J. J. Warr, <sup>W. M. Infinger</sup> and <sup>F. G.</sup> Bishop, members and M. T. Fountain, Clerk of said Board, which was a quorum of said Board, the following, among other things, were had and done to-wit:

Commissioner G. M. Bishop presented resolution, and same being seconded by Commissioner W. M. Infinger, was, upon motion, put before the board, and all members voting aye and none nay, resolution was adopted, said resolution being in words and figures as follows:

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, are, under provisions of Senate Bill No. 646, Acts of the Legislature of 1927, approved by the Governor on the 28 day of May, 1927, duly authorized to issue and sell bonds of said county to an amount not exceeding three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) for the purpose of constructing a toll bridge, bridges, causeway or highway, across Choctawhatchee River at a point designated in said act to be not more than 6 miles North or 6 miles South of a place where said river crosses the base line, and

Whereas, it is determined by this Board that it is to the interest and welfare of the tax payers of Walton County that such bridge, bridges, causeway or highway be constructed, and

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Whereas, there are no funds available to this Board for the purpose of constructing said toll bridge, bridges, causeway or highway,

IT IS RESOLVED:

1. That for securing funds for the purpose of constructing a toll bridge, bridges, causeway or highway across Choctawhatchee River, there be issued and sold bonds of Walton County, Florida, to an amount not exceeding three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00), said bonds to be in denomination of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) each, to be numbered from one to 30 (1 to 30) inclusive, to be dated July 1, 1927, to bear interest at the rate of either 5 1/2% or 6% per cent per annum payable semi-annually on the 1 day of January and July of each year, both interest and principal to be payable at the National Bank of Commerce in the City of New York, State of New York, and said bonds to mature and become payable on the 1 day of July, 1937; that said bonds be designated as Toll Bridge Bonds of Walton County, Florida.

Whereas, this Board of County Commissioners is duly authorized, under the provisions of House Bill No.1502, passed by the legislature session of 1927, approved by the Governor on the 3 day of June, 1927, to issue and sell bonds of Walton County in an amount not exceeding one million, two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$1,250,000.00) for the purpose of constructing, improving, repairing and rebuilding certain roads and bridges within the corporate limits of said County, and to provide for the levy and collection of a tax on all the taxable property within the corporate limits of Walton County for the purpose of providing a sinking fund to redeem said bonds at maturity and to pay the interest thereon, and

Whereas, under the provisions of said Act, the moneys to be provided by the issuance and sale of the said \$1,250,000.00 bonds are to be expended only as provided in said Special Act, which said Act specifically describes certain roads within the corporate limits of Walton County to be constructed, improved, repaired or rebuilt from the proceeds of the sale of said bonds, and

Whereas, this Board of County Commissioners deems it necessary, for the comfort and welfare of the tax payers of Walton County, Florida, that roads and bridges be constructed, improved, repaired or rebuilt, under the program outlined, as provided in said Special Act,


