

Monday, July 4th, A. D. 1927.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met at the Clerk's office in the town of DeFuniak Springs on this Monday, July 4th, 1927, with the following members present and participating,- W. I. Stinson, Chairman, W. M. Infinger and G. M. Bishop, together with S. M. Preacher, County Assessor of Taxes, and M. T. Fountain, Clerk of said Board, and also pursuant to adjournment of July 15th, A. D. 1927.

Pursuant to Section 723, Revised General Statutes of Florida, the County Assessor of Taxes met with the Board of County Commissioners at the Clerk's office for the purpose of hearing complaints and receiving testimony as to the value of any property, real or personal, as fixed by the County Assessor of Taxes, of perfecting, reviewing and equalizing the assessment, and there being no one present to make any complaint, it was ordered that the Board stand adjourned until to-morrow, Tuesday, July 5th, A. D. 1927.
