

REGULAR MEETING, TUESDAY, JULY 12th, A.D. 1927.

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The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in Regular session on this Tuesday, July 12th, A D 1927, and pursuant to adjournment of July 5th, A D 1927, with the following members present and participating, G M Bishop, R L Jones, W I Stinson, Chairman, W M Infinger and J J Ward, and M T Fountain, Clerk of said Board.

W F Jones, Tax Collector filed his report of Licenses collected for the period ending May 31st, 1927, showing \$62.00 collected for the State and \$33.25 for Walton County, and filed his report of Polls collected for the month ending May 31st, 1927, showing \$147.00, the above and foregoing reports was filed with the Clerk of this Board on June 1st, 1927.

W F Jones, Tax Collector filed his report of Licenses collected for the month ending June 30th, 1927, showing \$6.00 collected for the State and \$3.00 for Walton County, and his report of Polls collected for the month ending June 30th, 1927, showing \$220.00 collected, the said reports was filed with the Clerk of this Board on July 2nd, 1927.

Bond for duplicate warrant No.16761, issued April 12, 1927, to the DeFuniak Telephone Co. for \$25.85, having been filed with this Board, upon motion of G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried, it was ordered that duplicate warrant issue therefor.

Semi-Annual Report of County Finances for the period ending March 31st, 1927, having been prepared by the Clerk of this Board, it was ordered that same be approved and forward to the State Comptroller as now provided by law.

Minutes of the meetings of this Board held on June 6th, 7th, 14th and 15th, 1927, was read and upon corrections as above outlined in the resolutions, upon motion made by J J Ward seconded by G M Bishop and duly carried by unanimous vote, was ordered approved as amended.

The twenty (20) Petitions filed with the Clerk of this Board on July 5th, 1927, asking this Board to issue \$50,000.00 worth of County Bonds for the purpose of constructing and equipping of a hospital in said County under and pursuant to an act of the Legislature of Florida, Regular Session, 1927, having been submitted to W F Jones, Tax Collector and Ex-officio ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ Supervisor of Registration of Walton County, Florida, for his examination and consideration, and the said W F Jones, Tax Collector and Ex-Officio Supervisor of Registration of Walton County, Fla., having examined the same, returned the same to this Board with the following letter or certificate.-

Dear Sirs:-

I have carefully examined the attached petitions relative to the County Hospital and I hereby certify that said petition contains over fifty-one percent of free holders being registered voters.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Mr J J Ward, seconded by Commissioner Mr G M Bishop, and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the following resolution be adopted,-

There having been filed with the Board, on July 5th, 1927, twenty petitions, each of which contained the same language and identical in form and substance, except as to the names signed thereto, petitioning this Board to issue County Bonds in the sum of \$50,000.00 for the purpose of constructing and equipping a hospital and acquiring a site therefor, pursuant to and under the provisions of an act of the Legislature of Florida, Regular Session, 1927, entitled "An Act to authorize the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, to issue bonds for the construction of a hospital or hospitals, prescribing the conditions upon which such authority may be exercised, providing for the acquiring of a site or sites for such hospital or hospitals, the construction of the same and for their or its management and contract when constructed, and other purposes incident to such proposals" and the Board having examined said petitions and found that they have been signed by at least fifty-one per cent of the registered voters of said County who are free-holders.

Be it Resolved that this Board shall and does hereby find and determine that said petitions have been signed by at least fifty-one per cent of the registered voters of said County who are free-holders.

Be it further resolved that further action upon said petitions be postponed until the next Regular meeting to be held in August, 1927.

Upon motion made by Commissioner G M Bishop, seconded by Commissioner J J Ward, and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the following resolution be adopted,-

Whereas, it is necessary under the law that trustees for the bonds to be issued by the County for the purpose of removing, remodeling and reconstructing the County jail as authorized by the Legislature of 1927, be appointed.

Therefore, be it resolved that Howard L Cawthon, G B Campbell and D S Sellars, be and they are hereby appointed as financial committee who shall be styled trustees of County Bonds and each of whom shall give bond in the sum of \$3,000.00, running to W I Stinson, as Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, and his successors in office conditioned as required by law.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the proceeds of the sale of said bonds shall be paid over to said trustees as and when received and said trustees have qualified by giving bond as aforesaid, such proceeds to be distributed by said trustees for the purpose for which such bonds shall have been sold and for no other purpose.

Mr W M Henley, appeared before the Board and requested the Board to consider an appropriation for the employment of a Home Demonstration Agent for this County during the current budget year.

The following bills against the various County Funds were then considered and being found correct and legally due, upon motion made by R L Jones and seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that bills be paid and warrants drawn therefor as follows, to-wit:

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A Petition signed by A F Hall, J M Campbell, R A Frazier, et al asking this Board to grant a public road beginning at or near the Southwest corner of Section 18 Twp and leading in a southeasterly direction to the Northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 30 Tp 4 N R 19 W, thence due South on half Section of said Section 30 to the north line of Sec. 31 same Township and Range, thence in a Southeasterly direction to bridge on Gum creek about one-half mile south of Henry Collingworths place, and another

Petition signed by H C Herring, J M Hall, W T Redmon, et al asking for a public road be granted, Beginning at the Colingsworth bridge on Gum creek, running along West line of Hutch Cawthon place, thence through W B Harbeson land to S E Corner of W A Frazier's old place, thence North by Campbell's Rest School House to North line of H C Cawthon & Sam Redmon land thence along Jackson Lbr Co's old log road to Glendale and Cluster Spgs road,- and the said petitions were considered and there being no right-of-way deeds on file the Board delayed further consideration of these petitions until July 23rd, 1927.

The Board was advised that the \$300,000.00 Toll Bridge Bonds would be required to be validated thru the Circuit Court before the bond attorneys would approve of the issue, and after considerable discussion with Hon. D. Stuart Gillis, County Attorney, he made the following proposition,- he agreed to validate same for \$300.00 if no opposition, \$500.00 if apposed in the Circuit Court and if appealed to the Supreme Court the sum of \$750.00, fee to be paid only and when bonds are sold,

The proposition was considered and upon motion of Commissioner G M Bishop, seconded by Commissioner R L Jones, it was ordered that Hon. D. Stuart Gillis, Attorney, be and he is hereby employed to represent Walton County, Florida, in the validation proceedings for the sum of 300.00 for validationg the same thru the Circuit Court of Walton County and if opposed in the Circuit Court the sum of 500.00 and if appealed to the State Supreme Court of this State the sum of \$750.00, fees to be paid only and when bonds are sold.

The Members of the Board authorized its Chairman, Mr W I Stinson, to purchase 7 rolls of guard wire for use on Bruce Creek fills and H Bludworth was authorized to get out the posts of all heart pine, size 6 x 6 - 7 ft long.

The Board signed a certificate certifying Hattie Bowers is a resident of this County and entitled to free admission to the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind, in accordance with Sec. 4 Chapter 5209 of the Laws of Florida.

It was then ordered that the Board stand adjourned until 2 o'clock P.M., Saturday, July 23rd, A D 1927.
