

TUESDAY, September 6th, 1927.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in Regular Session on this Sept. 6th, 1927, pursuant to adjournment of Tuesday, Aug. 23rd, 1927, and pursuant to due notice given in both of the local papers, with the following members present and participating,- W. I. Stinson, Chairman, J J Ward, G M Bishop, W M Infinger and R L Jones.

W F Jones, Tax Collector, filed his report of polls collected for the month ending August 31st, 1927, showing \$31.00 collected, and his report of Licenses collected for the month ending August 31, 1927, showing \$9.00 for the State and \$4.50 for Walton County.

Notary Public Bond of William T. Ray, \$500.00, with American Surety Co. of New York as surety.

Mr J T Herring was before the Board in regard to securing a Confederate Pension, stating that he was in the Alabama Home Guard during the Civil War and was unable to furnish the required proof as his comrades were all dead, the Board advised him that they could not

take any actions until he had submitted the proper proof.

Minutes of the meetings of this Board ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ of August 9th, 10th and 27th, A D 1927, was read by the Clerk and upon motion of J J Ward, seconded by R L Jones, and duly carried, was ordered approved as read.

RESOLUTION.

Upon motion of Commissioner, J J Ward seconded by Commissioner, R L Jones, and duly carried, it was ordered that the following resolution be adopted,-

Whereas, in making up the 1926-1927 Budget the Board of County Commissioners, appropriated the sum of \$6,000.00 for Sheriff and Deputies, cost bills in criminal cases, and the sum of \$200.00 for Sheriff's commission on fines & etc collected, to be paid out of the Fine and Forfeiture Fund, and appropriated the sum of \$2750.00 to pay Tax Collector Commission and the sum of \$2750.00 to pay the Tax Assessor commission, and

Whereas, the above amounts are insufficient to pay the above described officers their fees and commissions, and there is and was sufficient funds in the Fine and Forfeiture Fund and the General Revenue Fund to pay the said officers.

Therefore, be it, resolved, that the State Comptroller of the State of Florida, be and he is hereby requested to authorize this Board to pay the above named officers their fees and commissions not exceeding the following amounts from the unexpended and unappropriated funds of Walton County,- Tax Assessor's Commission the sum of \$716.90, Tax Collector's Commission the sum of \$600.00, Sheriff's and Deputies, cost bills in criminal cases, the sum of \$2,960.77, and the sum of \$164.28 for Sheriff's commission on fines et collected.

And with the approval of the State Comptroller, the Clerk of this Board be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make the proper enteries on the records of his office.

The Clerk was instructed to write to various West Florida counties about leasing our County Convicts during the current budget year.

It was ordered that the following Road Overseers be ^{or not} approved for the year 1927, or until their successors are appointed and qualified,-

Arthur Permenter, Road Overseer on road from New Home Still to Billups place on Freeport road, road known as Pine Island Road.

J R H Shunk, Road Overseer on road from Santa Rosa to Eden Park Ferry Landing and from Santa Rosa West to Okaloosa County line, roads known as the Santa Rosa roads.

Earl Matthews, Road Overseer on road from Call Williamson place via J M Armstrong to Argyle and Eucheeanna road, road known as the Mail Route road.

The following bills against the various county funds were then investigated and being found correct and legally due, upon motion of J J Ward, seconded by W M Infinger, and duly carried by unanimous vote, were ordered paid and warrants drawn therefor as follows,-
