

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this September 9th, 1927, pursuant to adjournment of September 6th, A D 1927, with the following members present and participating,- W I Stinson, Chairman, G M Bishop and R L Jones, the same being a quorum of the Board present.

Upon motion of G. M. Bishop, seconded by R L Jones, it was ordered that the resolution heretofore, to-wit: on June 15th, 1927, adopted authorizing the issuance of road and bridge bonds in the sum of \$1,250,000.00, said resolution appearing of record in Volume 7, pages 465, 466 and 467, in which the rate of interest said bonds should bear was fixed at  $5\frac{1}{2}\%$  or  $6\%$ , be amended by striking out the words and figures "Eigher  $5\frac{1}{2}\%$  or  $6\%$  per cent", and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures " $5\frac{1}{2}\%$  per annum" so that the rate of interest said bonds shall bear shall be and is hereby definitely fixed at  $5\frac{1}{2}\%$  per cent.

Resolution

Upon motion of Commissioner, G. M. Bishop and seconded by Commissioner, R. L. Jones, and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, the following resolution was ordered adopted,-

Whereas, in making up the 1926-1927 Budget, the item appropriated for "Cost of Material" and the amount appropriated for "Tools and machinery, cost and repairs" is insufficient to take care of the current needs of the County, and

Whereas, the amount appropriated for "Live Stock, cost and care and feeding" and the amount appropriated for "Paid for free labor other than guards" and the item appropriated for "Civil Engineer" is more than sufficient to take care of the current needs of the County.

Therefore, be it, Resolved, That the State Comptroller of the State of Florida be and he is hereby requested to authorize this Board to transfer the sum of \$534.13 from "Paid for Free Labor, other than Guards" and the sum of \$9.56 from the item of "Civil Engineer" to the item of "Tools and machinery, cost and repairs" and to be expended for the last named item, and to transfer the sum of \$102.28 from "Civil Engineer" and the sum of \$130.18 from the item of "Live Stock, cost and care and feeding" to the item of "Cost of Material" and to be expended for the last named item.

And further resolved, that with the approval of the State Comptroller that the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make the proper enteries in his records.

The Board then adjourned to meet in regular session on Friday, Sept. 30th, 1927.

FRIDAY, September 30th, 1927.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this September 30th, 1927, with the following members present and participating, G M Bishop, J J Ward, R L Jones and W I Stinson, Chiarman, the meeting was held pursuant to adjournment of September 9th, 1927. Hon. D. Stuart Gillis, Attorney for County Commissioners was present to advise the Board.

The Resolutions adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on September 6th, 1927, was approved by the State Comptroller on September 9th, 1927, and filed with the Clerk.

Mr. J. C. McSween, representing Miller & McSween and Mr A G Douglass, representing Douglass & Permenter, was before the Board in regard to the 1926 taxes on their cattle, stating to the Board that they disposed of their cattle during 1926 and wanted the Board to allow them a deduction, but upon advise of D. Stuart Gillis, Attorney, the Board advised Mr J C McSween and Mr A G Douglass that the Board did not have any legal right to allow this deduction.

Notary Public bond of Archie B. Young, \$500.00 with American Surety Company of New York as surety, was approved.

Bond of E. W. Thorpe, \$10000.00 for Member State Board of Forestry, was approved with American Surety Co. of New York as Surety.

Moved by J J Ward, seconded by G M Bishop and duly carried, ordered that Warrant #90, drawn upon the Agriculture and Live Stock Fund in favor of W J Miles on Aug. 9th, 1927, for \$20.75 be cancelled.

The following bills against the various county funds were then examined and being found correct and legally due, upon motion of J J Ward, seconded by R L Jones and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present were ordered paid and warrants drawn therefor, as follows, to-wit:-


