

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in Regular Session on this Tuesday, December 13th, 1927, with the following members present and participating, - W. I. Stinson, Chairman, R L. Jones, J J Ward and W M Infinger.

W F Jones, Tax Collector filed a Supplemental report of 1925 polls collected during the month of February, 1926, showing \$76.00 collected and also filed a supplemental report of 1924 polls collected during the months of May, June, July, Aug. Sept. and Oct. 1926, showing \$46.00 collected, also a supplemental report of 1925 polls collected during Oct. Dec. 1926 and June 1927, showing \$18.00 collected, the reports having been filed with the Clerk of this Board on November 26th, 1927.

W F Jones, Tax Collector filed his report for the month ending November 30th, 1927, showing \$49.00 collected for 1927 poll taxes, and his report of Licensees collected for the month of November 30th, 1927, showing \$336.00 for the State and \$168.00 for Walton County.

Commissioner J J Ward having been instructed to proceed to Calhoun County, Fla. heretofore by this Board reported and filed with the Clerk of this Board a due bill from Calhoun County showing that they owed Walton County, Fla. the sum of \$598.32 for the lease of our County Convicts, and advised the Board that Calhoun County was not interested in leasing our Convicts for another year.

The Bills of The H & W B Drew Company of Jacksonville, Fla. dated Nov. 16, 1927, one for \$30.34 for 1 M Printed original summons Blanks, Invoice No.491927, and Invoice dated Nov. 16, 1927, Invoice No.491928 for 500 Printed Marriage Affidavit Blanks, \$25.00, was considered by the Board together with the correspondance between the said Drew Co. and the Clerk of this Board, it was ordered that the bills be dis-allowed and the Clerk instructed to instruct the County Judge of Walton County who purchased the same to return the blanks to the said Drew Co.

Upon motion of R L Jones seconded by J J Ward it was ordered that the name of Mrs Mollie Mayhappy, Laurel Hill, Fla. Rte #3 % Mrs J P Bartlett be placed upon the Pauper's List to receive the sum of \$2.00 per month until further orders of this Board.

A Map or Plat known as Midway Farms, Subdivision of SE $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 30 Tp 3 N R 19 W was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, for their approval and the Board of County Commissioners finding that the map or plat complies Chapter #10275, Laws of Florida, in so far as they are able to determine, upon motion of J J Ward, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, it is ordered that the Clerk of this Board be and he is hereby authorized and directed to approve the same in the name of and for the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, the map or plat was properly signed by C C Cain, agent for Cain and Vanzandt.

A Map or Plat known as Stinson Subdivision of the N $\frac{3}{4}$ of Block 1554, according to the map of the Vicinity of the town of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, by W J Vankirk, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, for approval, the map or plat being properly sworn to or acknowledged by W I Stinson, et ux, and the Board of County Commissioners finding the same to comply with Chapter #10275, Laws of Florida, in so far as they are able to determine, upon motion of J J Ward, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, it is ordered that the Clerk of this Board be and he is hereby authorized and directed to approve of the same in the name of and for the said Board of County Commissioners of Walton, County, Florida.

A Map or Plat known as West End Heights, Subdivision of Blocks 1911, 1912, 1913 and parts of 1907 and 1849, according to map of vicinity of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, drawn by W J Vankirk, being in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 27 and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 34 Tp 3 N R 19 W, the West End Heights subdivision being properly sworn to and acknowledged by L E Love, et ux, and the map or plat complying with Chapter #10275, Laws of Florida, in so far as the Board of County Commissioners could

determine, upon motion made by J J Ward, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, it was ordered that the Clerk of this Board be and he is hereby authorized and directed to approve of the same in the name of and for the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida.

Mr Tommie Price was before the Board in regard to a public road passing thru his land near Cluster Springs, and he was instructed to proceed to procure deeds to the right of way and the board would authorize the change as he desired, at their regular meeting in January, A D 1928.

Mother's Pension claim of Mrs Ester Marlow of Darlington, Fla. was considered and same being found to comply with the Laws, upon motion made by J J Ward, seconded by R L Jones and duly carried by unanimous vote, ordered that her name be placed upon the Mother's Pension list to draw the sum of \$3.00 per month until further orders of this Board.

And further ordered that the name of Mrs Carl Slay be stricken from the Mother's Pension list, for the reasons she is not now residing in Walton County, and further ordered that Warrant #17246, issued Nov. 8th, 1927, for \$3.00 be cancelled and

Further ordered that the name of Mrs Temp Boyett be stricken from the Pauper's list for the reason she is now residing in or near Perry, Fla. and that Warrant #17170, issued Nov. 8th, 1927, for \$5.00 be cancelled.

The Clerk of this Board was instructed to write to the State Road Department with regard to leasing or letting the State Road Department work our County Convicts.

Minutes of the meetings of this Board held on Aug. 23rd, Sept. 6th, 9th and 30th, Oct. 3rd, 11th, Nov. 8th, 16th, 19th, and Nov. 29th, 1927, was read and upon motion of J J Ward, seconded by R L Jones and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, was ordered approved as read.

Letter from Governor Martin's Secretary dated Nov. 9th, 1927, was read for information the information of Board.

Mother's Pension application of Mrs Glayds P Cohran, Santa Rosa, Fla. was considered and ordered that her name be placed upon the Mother's Pension List to receive the sum of \$3.00 per month until further orders of this Board.

Mother's Pension Application of Mrs Ausley Jones was not approved because it was not complete and did not furnish the information required by the acts of 1927.
