

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this Monday, January 2nd, A D 1928, as provided by law, with the following members present and participating, W. I. Stinson, Chairman, G M Bishop, R L Jones, W M Infinger and J J Ward.

Upon motion made by R L Jones, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried, it was ordered that Arthur Adkison be and he is hereby appointed as Road Overseer on road leading from Glendale in Walton County, Florida to near S. Wilkerson place in Walton County, Florida, road known as Glendale and Florala road.

As provided by Section 1572, Revised General Statutes of Florida, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, examined the sufficiency of the various County Officers Bonds, and all were found sufficient except, A R Campbell, County Judge, and it was ordered that the Clerk of this Board be and he is hereby authorized and directed to Advise Governor John W. Martin of the State of Florida, that by reason of the death of the sureties on the bond of A R Campbell, County Judge, that they believed the bond had become impaired.

Upon motion of R L Jones, seconded by G M Bishop and duly carried, it was ordered that the name of George Carter, Red Bay, Fla. be placed upon the Pauper's List to receive the sum of \$3.00 per month until further orders of this Board and further ordered that the name of J H Warr, Paxton, Fla. be placed upon the Pauper's List to receive the sum of \$7.50 per month until further orders of this Board.

A Road Petition signed by Andrew Thompson, W D Port and various other citizens of Santa Rosa, Florida, was received and after consideration, upon motion made by W M Infinger seconded by J J Ward and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the Road beginning at the North boundary of the Town of Santa Rosa, Fla. on a line running North, between Sections 14 and 15, Township 2 South, Range 20 West, being a continuation of Ninth Street, North, in the town of Santa Rosa, said road to extend to the Choctawhatchee Bay, approximately one mile and 350 feet ^{and designated} be and the same is hereby declared/a public road of Walton County, Fla.

A Petition signed by James Weston, H W Weston and Adrian Walline of Santa Rosa, Fla. was filed with the Board on Dec. 29th, 1927, asking the Board to change the Eastern limit of Santa Rosa, voting Precinct #18, one mile further East, all the way from the Bay to the Gulf, was considered, but no action was taken at this time as the Board expects to consider matters of this nature at a later date.

Petition signed by W H Ward and sundry other citizens of the Point Washington neighborhood asking the County Commissioners in re-districting the County to include Voting Precinct No 15 (Point Washington) in County Commissioner's District No.5, but no action taken at this time because the Commissioners expects to discuss this matter at a later date .

A Letter signed by Lynn Nealley, Secty, Local Branch, G.C.H.A. Santa Rosa, stating that in case of re-districting the County into Commissioners Districts, to retain Santa Rosa voting Precinct #18, in commissioner's district No.4, the letter was filed for further considerations.

A Petition signed by W H Ward and sundry other citizens of Point Washington neighborhood was filed with the Board asking the board to have the road leading from Pt. Washington East to the Bay County line be repaired, but Board agreed to consider this matter at an ^{early} date and have same done.

Upon motion made by W M Infinger, seconded by J J Ward and duly carried by unanimous vote, ordered that the Road ~~beginning~~ leaving the Boggy Road near Mrs J B Alford's place and following the present settlement road as near as practical to State Road No.1, East of S K Gillis's place be declared and designated a public road of Walton County, Florida.

A Road petition signed by Henry Collinworth and sundry other citizens of Walton County, asking that the road beginning at N E Corner of ^{1/4} of NW¹ Sec 32 Tp 4 N R 19 W or

at the corner of Henry Collinsworth lane and run due West to intersect with Florala and DeFuniak Springs road, be designated and declared a public road, the petition was referred to Commissioner R L Jones for investigation, and to be further considered by this Board at its next regular meeting.

Minutes of the meetings of this Board held on December 13th and 19th, 1927, was read by the Clerk and upon motion made by J J Ward, seconded by R L Jones and duly carried was ordered approved as road.

As provided by Chapter 12068, Laws of Florida, the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, personally selected and made out the following list of names of persons qualified to serve as jurors for the years 1928 and 1929, the list containing not less than two hundred and ninety nor more than five hundred persons properly qualified to serve as jurors being as follows, to-wit:
