

TUESDAY, January 3rd, A D 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners of Alton County, Florida, met on this January 3rd, A D 1928, pursuant to adjournment of yesterday, January 2nd, 1928, with the following members present and participating, - W I Stinson, Chairman, J J Ward, R L Jones, G M Bishop and W M Infinger, and M T Fountain, Clerk of said Board.

Moved by G M Bishop, seconded by R L Jones and duly carried, ordered that the name of Wm. Brown be stricken from the Paupers List, also the name of Annie Agerton be stricken from the Mother's Pension list, Mr Brown having died recently and Mrs Agerton having married recently.

Upon motion made by J J Ward, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried by unanimous vote, ordered that the action of Commissioner I Stinson in discontinuing the services of M C Burch as Tractor Driver for General County work on Dec. 21, 1927, because the plan of having a general county tractor having been abandoned be approved

W F Jones, Tax Collector, filed his report of Polls collected for the month ending Dec. 31, 1927, showing \$26 00 collected, and his Licenses report for same period showing

\$100.00 collected for the State and \$50.00 for Walton County.

Mr Will H Ward of Pt. Washington, appeared before the Board in regard to the condition of the Pt. Washington and Bay County road, the Board agreed to give same early attention.

Mother's Pension application of Mrs Lillie V. Whitton, P O address, DeFuniak Spgs, was filed and considered, moved by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried, ordered that her name be placed upon the Mother's Pension List to receive the sum of \$4.00 per month until further order of this Board.

Mr Malcolm Bruce and J J Ward was requested to go and inspect the Pt. Washington and Bay County road and draw up specifications to improve same.

Mr J R, D R, W R and G T Anderson appeared before the Board in regard to a road leading from near Pleasant Grove Church or School house and leading in a westerly direction to Juniper School House intersecting with Glendale and DeFuniak Road was discussed, and Mr M Bruce, County Engineer was instructed to make further surveys and report his findings to this Board at a latter meeting.

Upon motion made by W M Infinger, seconded by G M Bishop and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the road leaving Boggy Road near Bear Creek bridge in Sec 35-3N-20W and run North to Bear Head on best practical route via W D Locks, S M Mitchem and Freeman places be declared and designated as a public road of Walton County, Florida.

Moved by G M Bishop, seconded by J J Ward, and duly carried, ordered that Preston Davis be Road Overseer on road from Holmes County line near J A Neel's via Anderson Mill to West line of Dist. #1, near old Laird's place, road known as Argyle and Glendale Road. His commission to be for the year 1928 and until his successor is appointed and qualified.

F. A. Strickland was requested to deliver 15 loads of wood to County Jail for use of the prisoners.
