

TUESDAY, January 24th, 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this Tuesday, January 24th, 1928, pursuant to adjournment of January 3rd, 1928, with the following members present and participating, G M Bishop, J J Ward, R L Jones, W M Infinger and W I Stinson, Chairman and M T Fountain as Clerk.

The question of redistricting the various County Commissioners Districts and various voting precincts and the justice of the Peace districts was discussed pro and con and upon advise from Hon. D Stuart Gillis, Attorney, the Board decided to delay the matter until Jan. 31st, 1928, or until after the proper petitions were filed with the board praying for same.

The Board discussed the building of the new bridge across Seven Runs, and Mr M Bruce, County Engineer was authorized to increase the length of the bridge 15 or 30 feet, providing it was agreeable with the Contractors, J S Gaston and Penton-Mathis Constructing Co.

There was a petition filed with the Board from sundry citizens of Voting Precinct No 18 (Santa Rosa) asking that the precinct remain in the Commissioner's District No.4, and a petition signed by sundry citizens of Precinct No.15, (Pt. Washington) asking that the precinct be made a part of Commissioner's District No.5, the petitions were filed and tabled for the time being.

Notary Public Bond of A. F. Gates, \$500.00 with American Surety Co. of New York as surety was approved.

The Board then adjourned until Tuesday, January 31st, A D 1928.
