

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this Tuesday, January 31st, A D 1928, pursuant to adjournment of January 24th, A D 1928, with the following members present and participating,- G M Bishop, R L Jones, W I Stinson, Chairman, W M Infinger and J J Ward, and M T Fountain as Clerk.

Resolution relative to alteration of certain election districts and the creation of certain new election districts.

BE IT RESOLVED:-

That the boundaries of Election District No.4 shall hereafter be as follows:-

Beginning at Northeast corner of Sec. 28 Tp 6 N R 18 W and run West to Northwest corner of Sec. 30 Tp 6 N R 18 W., thence run South to Southwest corner of Sec.31 Tp 5 N R 18 W., thence run East to Southeast corner of Sec. 33 Tp 5 N R 18 W., thence North to point of beginning, the voting place to be at DARLINGTON SCHOOL HOUSE.

That the boundaries of Election District No.9 shall hereafter be as follows:-

Beginning at Northeast corner of Sec. 25 Tp 6 N R 19 W and run West 8 miles or to the Northwest corner of Sec. 26 Tp 6 N R 20 W., thence South three miles or to the SW corner of Sec. 2 Tp 5 N R 20 W., thence East two miles or to the SE corner of Sec.1 Tp 5 N R 20 W., thence South five miles or to the SW corner of Sec. 31 Tp 5 N R 19 W.,thence East six miles or to the SE corner of Sec. 36 Tp 5 N R 19 W., thence North eight miles or to place of beginning, the voting place or polling place to be at GASKIN SCHOOL HOUSE.

That the boundaries of Election District No. 3 hereafter be as follows:-

Beginning at NE corner of Sec. 1 Tp 4 N R 19 W., run thence West three miles or to NW corner of Sec. 3 Tp 4 N R 19 W., thence run South six miles or to the SW corner of Sec. 34 Tp 4 N R 19 W., thence East three miles or to SE corner of Sec. 36 Tp 4 N R 19 W., thence North six miles or to place of beginning, the voting place to be at GLENDA IE SCHOOL HOUSE.

That the boundaries of Election District No.19 shall hereafter be as follows:-

Beginning at NE Corner of Sec. 4 Tp 4 N R 18 W, run thence West three miles or to the NW corner of Sec. 6 Tp 4 N R 18 W, thence South six miles or to the SW corner of Sec. 31 Tp 4 N R 18 W, thence East three miles or to the SE corner of Sec. 33 Tp 4 N R 18 W, thence North six miles or to the place of beginning,- voting pr polling place to be at Sandy Creek School House.

That the boundaries of Election District No.13 shall hereafter be as follows:-

Beginning at the NE corner of fractional Sec. 31 Tp 2 N R 16 W, thence run West about seven miles or to the NW corner of Sec. 31 Tp 2 N R 17 W, thence South one mile or to the SW corner of Sec. 31 Tp 2 N R 17 W, thence West four miles or to the NW corner of Sec. 4 Tp 1 S R 18 W, thence South to the Choctawhatchee River, thence up the Choctawhatchee River to the point of beginning, - Polling place to be at the residence of J.J. WARD.

That the boundaries of Election District No. 18 shall hereafter be as follows:-

Beginning at the NE corner of fractional Sec. 19 Tp 2 S R 19 W, run in a westerly direction along the shore lines of Choctawhatchee Bay to the Okaloosa County line, thence South to the Gulf of Mexico, thence East along the shore line of the Gulf of Mexico to the SE corner of Fractional Sec. 7 Tp 3 S R 19 W, thence North to the Choctawhatchee Bay or place of beginning,- polling place to be at the Santa Rosa SCHOOL HOUSE.

That the boundaries of Election District No. 8 shall hereafter be as follows:-

Beginning at the SW corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 4 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence run West to the run of Sconiers Mill Creek, thence down the run of Sconiers mill creek to where it intersects with Alaqua Creek, thence down the run of Alaqua Creek to the Township line dividing Townships 1 N and 2 N Range 19 W, thence East to the SE corner of Sec. 34 Tp 2 N R 19W, thence North to NE corner of Sec. 27 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence West one half mile or to the SW corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 22 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence North on half Section line dividing sections 22 and 15 or to the SW corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 10 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence West to the SW corner of Sec. 10 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence North to the SW corner of Sec. 3 Tp 2 N R 19W, thence West one half mile or to the SW corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 4 Tp 2 N R 19 W, or point of beginning, - polling place to be at STEEL CHURCH.

That the boundaries of Election District No. 14 shall hereafter be as follows:-

Beginning at the North-east corner of Section 1 Tp 3 N R 19 W, thence West to North-west corner of Section 3 Tp 3 N R 19 West, thence South to South-west corner of Section 15 Tp 3 N R 19 W, thence East to Southeast corner of Section 15 Tp 3 N R 19 W, thence South to main line Louisville & Nashville R R Company, thence Easterly along said railroad to passanger depot in DeFuniak Springs, Florida, thence South-easterly across lake to center of Pine St., thence Southeasterly to center of Second Street, thence South along the center of Second Street and the Center of Bruce Creek Road being an extension of Second Street to center of Section 2 Tp 2 N R 19 West, thence South to Southwest corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2 Tp 2 N R 19 W thence East to Southeast corner Section 1 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence North along Township line dividing Townships 18 West and 19 West to place of beginning, polling place Walton County COURT HOUSE.

That the boundaries of Election District No. 20 shall hereafter be as follows:-

Beginning at L & N Railroad Depot in DeFuniak Springs, thence across lake^{to} center of Pine Street, thence South-easterly to center of Second Street, thence South along the center of Second Street and the center of Bruce Creek road, being an extension of Second Street, to center of Section 2 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence South to South-west corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2 Tp 2 N R 19 West, thence East to Southeast corner of Section 1 Tp 2 N R 19 West, thence South along Township line dividing Townships 19 West and 18 West to the Southeast corner Sec. 36 Tp 1 N R 19 West thence West along base line to point where base line is crossed by Alaqua Creek, thence North up the center of said creek to where said creek crosses the Township lines dividing Townships 1 N and 2 N thence East along said Township line to Southwest corner Section 35 Tp 2 N R 19 West, thence North on West line of Section 35 Tp 2 N R 19 W, and Section 26 Tp 2 N R 19 W, to North west corner Section 26 Tp 2 N R 19 West, thence West on South line of Sec. 22 Tp 2 N R 19 West to half Section line, thence North on half Section line thru Sections 22 Tp 2 N R 19 West and Section 15 Tp 2 N R 19 West, thence West on South line of Sec. 10 Tp 2 N R 19 W to Southwest corner Section 10 Tp 2 N R 19 West, thence North to Northwest corner Section 10 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence west on South line of Section 4 Tp 2 N R 19 W, to half Section line, thence North on half section line thru Section 4 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence North on half section line Section 33 Tp 2 N R 19 W to center of Section 33 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence East to Northeast corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33 Tp 2 N R 19 West, thence East to corporate limits of DeFuniak Springs, thence North to L & N R R, thence East along said R R to place of beginning, polling place CHAUTAUQUA AUDITORIUM.

Be it further resolved that there shall be and there is hereby created two new Election Districts to be numbered 23 and 24, as follows:-

Election District No. 23 shall be bounded as follows:-

Beginning at North-west corner Section 6 Tp 3 N R 20 W and running East on

Township line dividing Townships 3 N and 4 N to North-east corner Section 4 Tp 3 N R 19 West thence South to Southeast corner Section 16 Tp 3 N R 19 West, thence East to Southeast corner Section 15 Tp 3 N R 19 West, thence South to South-east corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34 Tp 3 N R 19 West, thence West to South-west corner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33 Tp 3 N R 19 West, thence North to South edge of right-of-way of State Road No.1, thence westerly along south edge of right-of-way of State Road No.1 to place where said road crosses range line dividing ranges 20 W and 21 W thence North on said range line to place of beginning, the polling place to be at SELLARS COMMISSARY.

Election District No. 24 shall be bounded as follows:-

Beginning at the NW corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28 Tp 3 N R 19 W, running in a Westerly direction along State Road No. 1, to where State Road No. 1 crosses the range line dividing Ranges 20 and 21, thence due South on range line to the SW corner of Sec. 31 Tp 2 N R 20 W, thence East on Township line dividing Townships 1 N and 2 N to Alaqua Creek, thence up Alaqua Creek to the mouth of Sconiers Mill Creek, thence up Sconiers Mill Creek to where said Creek crosses the section line dividing Sections 4 and 9, thence East to the SE corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 4 Tp 2 N R 19 W, thence North along half section line dividing sections 4 Tp 2 N R 19 W and Sections 33 and 28 Tp 3 N R 19 W to point of beginning, the polling place to be at PLEASANT RIDGE SCHOOL HOUSE.

Upon motion of Commissioner R L Jones, seconded by Commissioner G M Bishop, the foregoing resolution was adopted the vote being as follows:- For the resolution, J J Ward, W M Infinger, R L Jones, G M Bishop, W I Stinson, Against the resolution None.

RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO CREATION OF JUSTICE OF THE PEACE DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS there now exists confusion as to the boundary lines of certain Justice of the Peace Districts, and

WHEREAS certain parts of the county are not included in any Justice of the Peace Districts, and

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by the Board of County Commissioners to alter certain existing districts and to constitute other districts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the county shall be and is hereby divided into ten Justice of the Peace Districts to be composed of the following described territory, to-wit:-

Justice of the Peace District Number/^{ed}1 shall be composed of Election districts Numbered 4 and 9.

Justice of the Peace District Numbered 2 shall be composed of election district Numbered 5. 2 1

Justice of the Peace District Numbered 3 shall be composed of election districts Numbered 3, 19 and 21.

Justice of the Peace District Numbered 4 shall be composed of election districts Numbered 7, 8, 14, 17, 20, 23 and 24.

Justice of the Peace District Numbered 5 shall be composed of election districts numbered, 1, 2 and 22.

Justice of the Peace District numbered 6 shall be composed of election districts Numbered 10 and 11.

Justice of the Peace District numbered 7 shall be composed of election districts Numbered 12 and 13.

Justice of the Peace District Numbered 8 shall be composed of election district Numbered 18.

Justice of the Peace District Numbered 9 shall be composed of election district

Number 15.

Justice of the Peace District Numbered 10 shall be composed of election districts Numbered 6 and 16.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in January, 1929.

RESOLUTION CHANGING THE BOUNDARIES OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

DISTRICT NUMBERED 3.

WHEREAS, petition has been filed with this Board signed by two-thirds of the registered voters of County Commissioners District 3 and praying for a change in the boundaries of said district so that same shall hereafter be bounded as follows, to-wit:-

Beginning at the SE corner of Township 4 North Range 19 West, thence running South along the range line to the SE corner of Township 1 North Range 19 West, thence West along the Base line to the middle of Alaqua Creek at a point where said creek crosses said Base Line; running thence Northerly up the middle of said creek to a point where said creek intersects the line dividing Townships 1 North and 2 North, thence Easterly along said last named line to the SE corner of Section 34 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence North along Section lines to SE corner of Section 22 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence West to the SW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence North along the half Section lines to the NE corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence West to the SW corner of Section 10 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence North along Section line to the SW corner of Section 3 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence West along Section line to SW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence North along the half Section lines of said Section 4 and Sections 28 and 33 of Township 3 North Range 19 West to the South side of the right-of-way of State Road Number 1, thence Westerly along the South side of the right-of-way of said State Road Number 1 to a point where said State Road Number 1 intersects the range line dividing Ranges 20 West and 21 West, thence South along said range line to the SE corner of Township 2 North Range 21 West, thence West along the said Township line to the boundary between Walton and Okaloosa Counties, thence North along said County line to the NW corner of Township 3 North Range 21 West, thence Easterly along the Township line dividing Townships 3 North and 4 North to point of beginning.

WHEREAS, said petition has been found by this Board to be in order, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the boundaries of said County Commissioners District Numbered 3 be and the same are hereby altered in accordance with said petition and that the same shall hereafter be bounded as above set forth.

RESOLUTION CHANGING THE BOUNDARIES OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS DISTRICT NUMBERED 4.

WHEREAS, petition has been filed with this Board signed by two-thirds of the registered voters of County Commissioners District Numbered 4, and praying for a change in the boundaries of said district so that same shall hereafter be bounded as follows, to-wit:

Beginning on the range line dividing Ranges 20 and 21 West in Walton County, Florida, where the same crosses State Road Number 1 and at the South side of the right-of-way of said State Road No. 1, running thence South on said range lines to the Township line dividing Townships 1 North and 2 North, thence West to the County line dividing Okaloosa and Walton Counties; running thence South along said County line to the Gulf of Mexico, thence Easterly along the shore of said Gulf of Mexico to the section line dividing Sections 7 and 8 in Township 3 South Range 19 West, thence due North to Choctawhatchee Bay, thence North Westerly across said Bay to the middle of the mouth of Alaqua Bayou, thence up the middle of said Bayou and the middle of Alaqua Creek to a point where said creek intersects the Township line dividing Townships 1 North and 2 North; thence Easterly along said Township line to the Section line dividing Sections 34 and 35 in Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence North to the NE corner of Section 27, Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence West to the SW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence North to the NE corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence West to the SW corner of Section 10 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence North along Section line to the NE corner of Section 9 Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence West to the South West corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 2 North Range 19 West, thence North along the half Section line of said Section 4 and of Sections 28 and 33 in Township 3 North Range 19 West to the South side of the right-of-way of said State Road Number 1, thence Westerly along the South side of the right-of-way of said State Road Number 1 to point of beginning.

WHEREAS, said petition has been found by this Board to be in order, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the boundaries of said County Commissioners District Number 4 be and the same are hereby altered in accordance with said petition and that the same shall hereafter be bounded as above set forth.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the change hereby effected shall become effective on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in January, 1929.

RESOLUTION CHANGING THE BOUNDARIES OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
DISTRICT NUMBERED 5.

WHEREAS, petition has been filed with this Board signed by two-thirds of the registered voters of County Commissioners District Numbered 5 and praying for a change in the boundaries of said district so that same shall hereafter be bounded as follows, to-wit:-

Beginning at a point on the Township line dividing Townships 2 North and 3 North where the same intersects the boundary line of Washington and Walton Counties and running thence West along said Township line to the SE corner of Township 2 North Range 18 West, thence South along the range line dividing ranges 17 West and 18 West to the SE corner of Township 1 North Range 18 West, thence West along the Base Line to the middle of Alaqua Creek where the same intersects said Base Line, thence down the middle of said Creek and the middle of Alaqua Bayou to Choctawhatchee Bay, thence South Easterly across said Bay to the line

dividing Sections 30 and 31 from Sections 29 and 32 in Township 2 South Range 19 West, thence South along said Section line to the Gulf of Mexico, thence South Easterly along the shore of said Gulf to the boundary of Bay County, thence North along the boundary line dividing Bay and Walton Counties and following the line dividing Washing^{ton} and Walton Counties up the Choctawhatchee River to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, said petition has been found by this Board to be in order, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED that the boundaries of said County Commissioners District Numbered 5 be and the same are hereby altered in accordance with said petition and that the same shall hereafter be bounded as above set forth.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the change hereby effected shall become effective on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in January, 1929.

Upon motion of Commissioner R L Jones, seconded by Commissioner G M Bishop, the foregoing resolution was adopted, the vote thereon being for the resolution, J J Ward, W M Infinger, R E Jones, G M Bishop, W I Stinson.

Against the resolution None.

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It was ordered that the Clerk be authorized to place an order for twenty-four new ballot boxes.

It was ordered that the Chairman and Clerk of this Board be authorized to execute a warrant on the Fine and Forfeiture Fund drawn on The Cawthon State Bank for \$392.10 made in favor of the First National Bank of DeFuniak Springs, Fla. for the purpose of transferring this item from The Cawthon State Bank to the County Depository.

Mr. Stinson, Chairman was instructed to obtain first hand information from Mr Nathan Mayo, Commissioner of Agriculture in regard to working the County Convicts on the County roads and if he thought advisable to work them to the best advantage of the County.

A Road Petition signed by Boss Brackin, et al asking that the road beginning at SW corner of Sec 21-2N-19W and running East on line one half mile, thence North across Section 21 to the line of Sixteen, between 16 and 21, from this point east upon said line to the Freeport and DeFuniak Springs public road, was received and filed, and it was ordered thattsaid petition be tabled until the Board could examine the proposed route.

The Board then adjourned until the next regular meeting or upon call of its Chairman.
