

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this Tuesday February 14th, 1928, (Regular Session), with the following members present and participating, W. I. Stinson, Chairman, G M Bishop, R L Jones, J J Ward and W M Infinger, and M T Fountain, Clerk.

Mr Burruss Cawthon appeared before the Board in regard to the condition of the road leading from State Road No.1, near S K Gillis farm South to the Boggy Road via his farm, the condition caused by the heavy loads hauled over said road by trucks belonging to Beach, Rogers & Co., and the Board agreed to do what they could within a short time.

W F Jones, Tax Collector filed his report of Licenses collected for the month of January 31st, 1928, showing \$246.50 collected for the State and \$148.25 for Walton County, and his report of Polls for collected for same period showing \$47.00 collected.

Notary Public bond of John R Anderson, \$500. with R L Ringo and D S Sellars as sureties was approved.

Notary Public bond of W I Stinson, \$500. with American Surety Co. of New York as surety was approved.

Upon motion made by W M Infinger, seconded by R L Jones, ordered that the amount given to Mrs Mary Stinson be increased to \$5.00 per month.

Mr W F Donaldson appeared before the board in regard to exemption his land from taxes on account of the physical condition he is now in, and the Board directed him to the Tax Collector.

Upon motion made by J J Ward, seconded by W M Infinger, ordered that the Name of Mrs Kattie Kelley be stricken from the mother's pension list because she has moved beyond the limits of Walton County, and the name of Mr Buddie Alford be stricken from the Paupers List because he is now confined in a State Institution for the Insane, and further

Ordered that the name of Mrs Buddie Alford, Darlington, Fla. R #2, be placed upon the Paupers list to receive the sum of \$5.00 per month until further orders of this Board.

And further ordered that the name of Mr T T Simmons, DeFuniak Springs, Fla. be placed upon the Paupers List to receive the sum of \$2.50 per month.

Motion made by R L Jones, seconded by J J Ward, ordered that the name of Mrs E E Hemphill, Darlington, Fla. R #2, be placed upon the paupers list to receive the sum of \$2.00 per month until further orders of this Board.

The application from The Breeze and The DeFuniak Herald was received asking for the job of publishing the delinquent tax list for the year 1928, and after considerable discussion upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried all members voting in the affirmative except W I Stinson who voted in the negative, it was ordered that The DeFuniak Herald be and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Delinquent Tax list will be published in for the year 1928 as provided by Section 756, R.G.S.

Upon motion made by R L Jones, seconded by W M Infinger, and duly carried, ordered that the name of Mrs Ethel Busbee, Laurel Hill, Fla. RFD #2, be placed upon the Mother's Pension list to receive the sum of \$3.00 per month until further orders of this Board.

And further ordered that the name of J H Warr be stricken from the paupers list and the name of Mrs J H Warr be placed thereon to receive the same amount he is now receiving. Mr J H Warr having been recently sent to the State Asylum for the Insane.

Mrs Mellie Evans, Argyle, Fla. RFD#1 appeared before the Board asking them to increase the pension she is now receiving, the board agreed to consider same, but explained to her the condition of the budget & etc.

Messrs G T Anderson, J M Teal, D R Anderson, J R Anderson, D D Ray, G B Smith and sundry other citizens of the Union and Sandy creek neighborhoods appeared before the Board

in regard to the proposed road from that neighborhood to DeFuniak Springs and after consideration discussion pro and con upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger, it was ordered that any action on the proposed project be delayed until the March meeting.

Mother's Pension application of Mrs Annie Martin, Freeport, Fla. was received and considered and it was ordered that her name be placed upon the mother's pension list to receive the sum of \$5.00 per month until further orders of this Board.

The Board agreed to go and inspect M C Ward's contract job on the Chestnut hill on Friday, A. M. Feb. 17th, 1928. and to deliver him warrant for part payment if found correct.
