The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in regular adjournment session on this Monday, April 2nd, A. D. 1928, pursuant to adjournment of Tuesday, March 13th, A. D. 1928, with the following members present and participating, W. I. Stinson, Chairman, G. M. Bishop, R. L. Jones, W. M. Infinger and J. J. Ward, and M. T. Fountain, Clerk.

Upon motion of Commissioner J. J. Ward, seconded by Commissioner G. M. Bishop, it was ordered that the Chairman and Clerk of this Board be and they are hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of this board and affix its seal to the Road and Bridge Bonds heretofore authorized to be issued under an act of the Legislature of 1927, in the sum of \$1,250,000.00, and to deliver the same to the purchasers thereof when so executed and the purchase price thereof pursuant to contract heretofore entered into, is paid to the Chairman of this board for the account of Walton County, Florida.

The vote on the foregoing motion or resolution was as follows:-

Due notice having been published in the regular weekly issues of the DeFuniak Herald a newspaper printed and published in Walton County, Florida, as required by law and in pursuance thereto the following bids were received and considered by said Board for grubbing and stumping of a forty foot right-of-way for public road beginning at SE Corner of Sec 27-2S-20W to the Gulf of Mexico in Walton County, Florida, along the Section line according to plans and specifications on file in the Clerk's office of said Board,-

I hereby bid for the clearing, stumping and removing all stumps, trees and roots in preparing road bed for grading and also to furnish labor as per specifications to follow tractor and make my bid at \$400.00 for the two miles of road extending from Butlers corner two miles south to the gulf, in Walton County, Florida.

Each bid having been considered pro and con and the bid of S M Mitchem being found to be the lowest and best bid, upon motion made by Commissioner W M Infinger, seconded by Commissioner J J Ward and duly carried by unanimous vote, ordered that the bid of S M Mitchem be accepted and contract awarded to him for the sum of 48¢ per cubic yard, upon condition that the said S M Mitchem enter into contract with said Board and furnish bond with two good and sufficient sureties to be approved by the Clerk and Chairman of this Board, and the Chairman and Clerk of this Board be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute contract with S M Mitchem in the name of, for and on behalf of said Board.

And the Clerk was instructed to return all checks to the unsuccessful bidders, and upon executies of Bond and Contract by the said F A Strickland and S M Mitchem and when approved by the Chairman and Clerk, the checks of these two bidders are to be returned.

The Board of County Commissioners having gone and inspected the Bridge across Seven Runs Creek built under contract by the Penton-Mathis Construction Co. and having found the same to be completed according to plans and specifications, upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by R L Jones and duly carried by unanimous vote, ordered that the sureties on the bond of Penton-Mathis Construction Co., be released therefrom, so that the Penton-Mathis Construction Co., could obtain their money deposited in one of the local banks for security.

The Board then adjourned to meet in term or at call of its Chairman.
