

MONDAY, April 30th, A. D. 1928 .

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County met in Regular Adjourned Session

on this April 30th, A. D. 1928, pursuant to adjournment of April 10th and April 24th, 1928, with the following members present and participating, - W. I. Stinson, Chairman, G M Bishop, W M Infinger and J J Ward.

Confederate Widow's Pension Claim of Mrs. Dora McLeod, widow of Capt. A. B. McLeod who died April 10th, 1928, at DeFuniak Springs, Fla. was approved as provided by law.

Due notice having been published as required by law that the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County would received sealed bids on this day for the purpose of clearing and grubbing a right-of-way thirty feet wide from Pleasant Grove School House to J M Teal's place. Contracts to be let in three projects. Project No.1 from Pleasant Grove School House to Sandy Creek. Project No.2, from Sandy Creek to West line of Ray Cemetery. Project No.3, from West line of Ray Cemetery to J M Teal's house, and pursuant thereto the following bids were received and considered. -

Project No.1, for \$100.00, D. R. Anderson.

Project No.1, for \$89.50, --- J. C. Edwards.

Project No.2, for \$164.00, -- A. N. Anderson.

Project No.1, for \$130.00 per mile,)

Project No.2, for \$190.00 per mile,))- S.M.Mitchem.

Project No.3, for \$110.00 per mile,)

Each bid having been considered pro and con upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the bid of J C Edwards be approved and contract awarded to him, his bid being found to be the lowest and best bid for Project No.1.

The bid of S M Mitchem for Projects Nos. 2 & 3 being found to be the lowest and best bid, upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the bid of S M Mitchem, for Project Nos. 2 & 3, be approved and contract awarded to him.

It was further ordered that the Chairman and Clerk of this Board be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute contracts with the successful bidders and approve bonds as required.

There being no further business before the Board, the Board adjourned.
