

May 28th, A D 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County met in regular adjourned session on this May 28th, 1928, pursuant to adjournment of May 15th, 1928, with the following members present and participating,- G M Bishop, W M Infinger, and W I Stinson, Chairman and M T Fountain, Clerk of said Board and Hon. D. Stuart Gillis, Attorney for County Commissioners.

Upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried, ordered that the bond for duplicate warrant issued to Mrs Will H Ward, on April 10, 1928 for \$31.25 be approved and duplicate warrant issued to her for said amount, she having advised the Board that the original was destroyed by fire.

Upon advise of Hon. D. Stuart Gillis, it was ordered that fifty absentee ballots ~~and~~ be printed for use of people leaving the State before the Primary Election to be held June 5th, 1928.

The Board then adjourned to 2 o'clock P M to-morrow, May 29th, A D 1928.
