

MONDAY, JUNE 4th, A. D. 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this Monday, June 4th, A D 1928, pursuant to adjournment of May 29th, 1928, and as provided by Law, with the following members present, and participating, - G M Bishop, R L Jones, W M Infinger, J J Ward and W I Stinson, Chairman and M T Fountain, Clerk of said Board.

As provided by law the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, prepared the ballot boxes for the General Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, June 5th, 1928, and delivered them or had them delivered <sup>to</sup> the various voting precincts of Walton County.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, and the County Assessor of Taxes (Hon. S M Preacher) met at the Clerk's Office in the Town of DeFuniak Springs, Walton County, Florida, as provided by Sec. 4, Chapter 8584, Acts of 1921, for the purpose of hearing complaints and receiving testimony as to the value of the property, both real and personal as assessed by the County Assessor of Taxes, and the members of said Board having fully discussed the facts as presented and upon an examination of the 1928 assessment roll decided to increase the valuation upon the following described property covering certain parcels of land, to-wit:
