

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in ~~ix~~ regular recessed session on this Saturday, October 27th, 1928, pursuant to a recess of October 24th, A D 1928, with the following members present and participating, W I Stinson, Chairman, J J Ward, R L Jones, G M Bishop and W M Infinger, and M T Fountain, Clerk of said Board.

Due notice having been published in the issues of the DeFuniak Herald that this Board would received sealed bids on this day for the purpose of clearing, grubbing and stumping of a right-of-way 30 ft. wide on a road leaving State Road #40 near Middle Creek and running via W S McCollough's place, L D Clark's and along Section line intersecting present public road near Henry Collinsworth's place, approximately 2 1/4 miles, and in pursuance thereto the following bids were received and considered by said board,-

Also due notice having been published in the issues of the DeFuniak Herald that this Board would receive sealed bids on this day for the purpose of stumping, grubbing and clearing of a right-of-way 30 ft. wide on a road leaving the Union and Glendale road near J C Edwards place and running in a Northerly direction along the present road as near as practical via John Broxton's via E S Padgett and intersecting with the DeFuniak and ~~XXXXXX~~ Geneva road near Red Bug School House, and in pursuance thereto the following bids were received and considered by said Board.

Also due notice having been published in the issues of the DeFuniak Herald that this Board would received sealed bids on this day for the purpose of clearing, grubbing, grading, surfacing and building, furnishing and placing necessary drainage structures on a road leaving the Argyle and Red Bay road at the end of the German lane, thence near Eucheeanna via Angus Campbell's place to Walden Bridge on Bruce Creek and known as Project #8.

Also for clearing, grubbing, grading and building, furnishing and placing necessary drainage structures on a road leaving the road now being constructed under Project #1 at Valley Church and running to Project #8 near Eucheeanna, and known as Project #9.

And in pursuant thereto the following bids or proposals were received and considered by said Board,-

Each of the above and foregoing bids was accompanied by certified or cashier's check as provided in said notice or invitation for bids.

After considering each bid pro and con, the board found that the bids submitted by W S & W M McCollough for clearing right-of-way, approximately 2 1/4 miles as described above was the same amount per acre, and the bidders being present and agreeing to go partners in the performance of said work, their bids being found to be the lowest responsible bidder, upon motion of R L Jones, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried, ordered that bids of W S & W M McCollough be accepted and contract awarded to them jointly, and further ordered that they give a good and sufficient bond in the sum of \$220.00 Dollars, to be approved by the Chairman and Clerk of this Board, and further ordered that the Chairman and Clerk of this Board execute the proper contract for the performance of said work in the name of, for and on behalf of this Board.

The bid of L M Padgett being found to be the lowest responsible bidder on the next project, (right-of-way approximately 4 miles), upon motion made by G M Bishop, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried, ordered that L M Padgett's bid be accepted and contract awarded to him, upon furnishing a good and sufficient bond in the sum of \$300.00, to be approved by the Chairman and Clerk of this Board, and further ordered that the Chairman and Clerk of this Board execute contract for the proper performance of said work in the name of-for and on behalf of this Board.

The bids or proposals submitted by G W Byrd on Projects #8 & #9 being found to be the lowest responsible bidder, upon motion of G M Bishop, seconded by J J Ward and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that G W Byrd's bids or proposals be accepted and contracts awarded to him for Projects #8 & #9, and further ordered that the Chairman and Clerk of this Board be and they are hereby authorized and directed to approve bonds and execute contracts for the performance of said work as required by notice and proposals, in the name of-for and on behalf of this Board.

W F Jones, Tax Collector, submitted his Insolvent Report for the year A D 1927, of errors, insolvences and double assessments, and the Board having carefully examined and compared the same, it was ordered that the same be accepted and approved and the Tax Collector be given credit for the following amounts, to-wit:- General Revenue Fund \$1790.64, Mother's Pension Fund \$179.06, Road & Bridge Fund \$1790.64, Fine & Forfeiture Fund \$716.24, Agriculture & Live Stock Fund \$179.06, School Fund \$3581.26, Publicity Fund \$716.24, Interest & Sinking Fund for Court House Bonds \$1432.48, Total County Taxes \$10,385.62, Road & Bridge Dist. #1, Interest & Sinking Fund \$575.23, Sub-School Districts \$2,844.73, Bonded School Districts 1, 3 & 16 \$810.19, Poll Taxes \$606.00, total State & County taxes \$15,221.77.

The Board then recessed until Thursday November 1st, 1928.
