

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in regular adjourned session on this Friday, March 8th, 1929, with the following members present and participating W T Stinson, Chairman, J J Ward, R L Jones and W M Infinger, being a quorum of said Board, and M T Fountain, Clerk of said Board.

Commissioner W. S. Green, was absent on account of sickness.

Deputy Sheriff bond of E. S. Marlow, \$1000.00 was approved with A. G. Douglass and M T King, as sureties.

Notary Public bond of T R Haley, \$500.00 with American Surety Company of New York as surety was approved.

Report of County Finances for the nine months period ending December 31st, 1928 as approved and ordered forward to State Comptroller.

Upon motion made by R L Jones, seconded by J J Ward and duly carried, ordered that the name of J J Lassiter, Laurel Hill, Fla. RFD #2 and Nancy Lassiter, Florala, Ala., Stella Rte % Berry Carnley be placed upon the paupers list to receive the sum of \$3.00 each per month, and further ordered that the name of Mrs F K Dennis, Laurel Hill, Fla. RFD #2 % R B Tucker, be placed upon the paupers list to receive the sum of \$5.00 per month, and further ordered that the name of Mrs Ella Mae Floyd, Lakewood, Fla. be placed upon the Mothers' Pension Fund to receive the sum of \$5.00 per month until further orders of this Board.

Upon motion made by R L Jones, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried, ordered that the bids of Penton-Mathis Construction Co., and Z. D. Adair, received by this Board on Feb'y 5th, 1929, for the construction of bridges and fills on the McGowan-Collinsworth road be rejected and their certified or cashier's checks returned to the respective bidders.

It was ordered that the order placed with the American Disinfecting Co., for 30 gallons of Obugo insect destroyer and 30 gallons Dye Disinfect by Deputy Sheriff Marlow for use in the County Jail be approved.

The Clerk was authorized to trade for a new protectograph machine for use in writing County warrants, the difference in new machine and old machine being \$60.00.

The minutes of the meetings of this Board held January 7th, 8th, 12th and 25th, February 5th, 12th and 20th, 1929 was read by the Clerk and upon motion made by J J Ward, seconded by R L Jones, was ordered approved as read.
