

MONDAY, April 15th, 1929.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, met on this Monday, April 15th, 1929, for the purpose of discussing the building of roads and bridges out of the bond moneys now on hand in the various Commissioners districts, with the following members present and participating, - W I Stinson, Chairman, Angus Green, R L Jones and J J Ward, being a quorum of said Board and M T Fountain, Clerk of said Board, also County Engineer, C R Horne was present at said meeting, also Mr Lee Mathis representing Penton-Mathis Construction Co.,

The Board discussed various and sundry matters in regard to our present construction of roads and bridges also financial condition.

The following letter was received and ordered spread upon the minutes of this Board.

Havana, Florida, April 12, 1929.

Board of County Commissioners, DeFuniak Springs, Fla., - -

Dear Sirs:- This is to notify you that no road right of way has been given, nor will be given, through my property south of Ponce de Leon, Florida, except upon the old road bed, and such additions to the west thereof and adjoining the old road bed as may be necessary to get the proper width. My property is described as follows:- The  $E\frac{1}{2}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  and  $SW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec 15 in Tp 3 N of R 17 West. And I hereby forbid you and all other persons from trespassing on any portion of said land, by digging up the soil, cutting trees or brush, molesting the fencing or even the grass, or in any other way or manner save as above particularly referred to.

This is final and you will govern yourself accordingly.
