

SATURDAY, APRIL 20th, 1929.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met on this Saturday, April 20th, 1929, pursuant to adjournment of April 9th, and 15th, A D 1929, with the following members present and participating,- W I Stinson, Chairman, Angus Green, W M Infinger and J J Ward, being a quorum of said Board and M T Fountain, Clerk.

Due notice having been given as required by Law in the issues of the DeFuniak Herald that this Board would receive sealed bids until 2 o'clock P.M., on this day for the sale of \$40,000.00 County Jail Bonds and \$50,000.00 County Hospital Bonds, and pursuant thereto the following proposals was received on the form adopted by this Board,-

Davies-Bertram & Co.--Bohmer-Reinhart & Co. by H C O'Brien,

For \$50,000 Hospital Bonds the sum of \$47,528.00.

For \$40,000 Jail Bonds the sum of \$38,032.00

Davies-Bertram & Co.--Bohmer-Reinhart & Co., by H C O'Brien,

For \$40,000. Jail bonds only the sum of \$38,800.00.

The Weil-Roth & Irving Co. Cincinnati, Ohio.

For \$40,000 Jail bonds only the sum of \$960.00 per thousand <sup>s</sup> -- \$38,400.

The Provident Savings Bank & Trust Co., Cincinnati, O.

For \$50,000 Hospital Bonds the sum of \$48,000.00

For \$40,000 Jail Bonds the sum of \$38,600.00.

After considering said bids pro and con, upon request of Mr Williams, representing Provident Savings Bank and Trust Co. of Cincinnati, he was <sup>allowed</sup> to withdraw his bid and certified check deposited with his bid. Commissioner R L Jones, present and participating.

Mr. O'Brien representing Davies-Bertram & Co. and Bohmer-Reinhart & Co., then asked the Board to allow him to call up his home office and see if they would not allow him to increase his bid after seeing the preliminary opinion of the Bond Attorneys which was granted, then he appeared before the Board and offered 96½ for both issues, and after being advised the Board would not accept this offer, he then offered 97 for both issues, then after more discussion, upon motion made by W M Infinger, seconded by R L Jones and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, it was ordered that all bids and proposals be rejected and the bidders certified checks returned to them.

Upon motion of Commissioner J J Ward, seconded by Commissioner W M Infinger, and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, the following resolution was ordered adopted,-

Whereas, in making up the 1928-1929 Budget, the amount appropriated for "Free Labor, other than Guards," "Tolls and Machinery, costs and Repairs" and "Live Stock, costs and care and feeding" is not sufficient to take care of the current needs, and

Whereas, the amounts appropriated for "Payments on account of roads built by contract", "Cost of Material" and "Payments on account of bridges built by contract" is more than sufficient to take care of the current needs.

Therefore, Be it Resolved, that the State Comptroller be and he is hereby requested to authorize this Board to transfer the sum of \$4000.00 from "Cost of Material" to "Tools and Machinery, cost and repairs" and the sum of \$2500.00 from "Payments on account of Roads built by Contract" to "Tools and Machinery, cost and repairs" and the sum of \$6425.50 from "Roads built by Contract" to "Free Labor, other than Guards" and the sum of \$1200.00 from "Bridges built by Contract" to "Live Stock, cost and care and feeding" and the sum of \$3800.00 from "Bridges built by Contract" to the item of "Free Labor, other than Guards" and to be expended for the last named items.


And further resolved, that with the approval of the State Comptroller, that the Clerk of this Board be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make the proper transfers in the records of his office.

Commissioner W M Infinger made a motion that each Commissioner expend not more than \$350.00 per month for the present budget year on account of the financial condition of the 1928-1929 budget, there being no second to same it was not carried.

The Clerk of this Board was instructed to publish notice that the next regular meeting of this Board would be held on Wednesday, May 8th, 1929, on account of Circuit Court being held during the second week of May.


The Board then adjourned until May 8th, 1929, or upon call of the Chairman.
