

REGULAR MEETING, Wednesday, May 8th, 1929.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in regular session on this Wednesday, May 8th, A D 1929, pursuant to due notice given by publicationⁱⁿ the issues of the DeFuniak Herald and the Breeze, with the following members present and participating, - W I Stinson, Chairman, J J Ward, Angus Green, R L Jones and W M Infinger, being all the members of said Board and M T Fountain, Clerk of said Board.

W T Ray, Tax Collector, filed his report of licenses collected for the month ending April 30th, 1929, showing \$77.00 collected for the State and \$38.50 collected for Walton County,

W T Ray, Tax Collector, filed his report of polls collected for the same period showing \$270.00 collected.

The appropriation in the 1928-1929 Budget being now exhausted for "Paupers", upon motion of R L Jones, seconded by J J Ward, it is ordered that all names now appearing upon the Paupers list be struck off the paupers list until next budget year to become effective after this meeting.

Moved by J J Ward, seconded by Angus Green and ordered that Commissioner Angus Green and Engineer C R Horn be and they are hereby authorized to build fills on Ponce de Leon and Red Bay road so the road will be passable, the cost not to exceed the sum of \$300.00.

Confederate Pension claim of Ben N Holman was approved as required by law, claim supported by affidavits of James S McKenney, Niceville, Fla. and John W S Cawthon of DeFuniak Springs, Fla., former member of Brady's Company E Forest Bn.

Moved by J J Ward, seconded by Angus Green and duly carried, ordered that the Clerk of this Board be and he is hereby authorized and directed to deliver to G W Byrd his warrants for final estimates on Projects Nos. 2 & 7 heretofore issued without requiring him to sign final receipts heretofore requested by this Board.

The Board discussed the sale of Hospital and Jail Bonds at private sale, and the Chairman was authorize to negotiate with bond buyers and report to this Board at a latter meeting, for confirmation.

Bond for duplicate warrant #10862 issued Mar. 12, 1929 to I H Wood for \$9.50 filed with W C Bartlett and W A Royals as sureties was approved and duplicate warrant ordered issued.

A Road petition signed by G L Williams, P M Wilkerson, Alphus Wilkerson and others was presented to this Board asking that the Board beginning at Brazewell place on State line and run Southeast thru Willliams and Wilkerson settlemen intersecting DeFuniak and Gaskin road at or near Buck Gainey place, the same was filed and Board agreed to construct same out of the bond moneys as soon as possible.

A Petition signed by C U Alford and others asking the Board to place the name of Mrs Lula Beck on the paupers list was received and filed, no action taken at this time because of the condition of the budget for such purposes is now exhausted.

Minutes of the meetings of this Board held on April 2nd, 9th, 15th and 20th, 1929 was read by the Clerk, upon motion of J J Ward, seconded by R L Jones and duly carried by unanimous vote, was ordered approved as read.

Mr W H Wesley, Jr. appeared before the Board in regard to opening a Ferry between Point Washington and the north side of Jolly Bay and after considerable discussion, upon motion made by Angus Green, seconded by W M Infinger and duly carried by unanimous vote, it was ordered that the Chairman and Clerk of this Board be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with W H Wesley, Jr. of Point Washington, Florida, in the name of said Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, that the said W H Wesley Jr. will operate said ferry from Pt. Washington to Jolly Bay twice daily during the months of June, July and August, 1929, and double daily service on Tuesday and single trip on Wednesday of each week during the other nine months of the year, Walton County to pay the said W H Wesley the sum of \$50.00 per month, rates to be \$2.00 for round trip and \$1.50 for single trip to be paid by people with cars crossing said Choctawhatchee Bay.

The following bills against the various county funds were then considered and being found correct and legally due, upon motion made by Commissioner Angus Green, seconded by Commissioner R L Jones and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present were ordered paid and warrants drawn therefor, as follows, to-wit:
