

SATURDAY, August 31st, 1929.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, in regular adjourned session on this Saturday, August 31st, A D 1929, pursuant to adjournment of August 26th, 1929, with the following members present and participating, - W I Stinson, Chairman, Angus Green, R L Jones, W M Infinger and J J Ward, being all the members of said Board and M T Fountain, Clerk of said Board.

Upon motion of Commissioner J J Ward, seconded by Commissioner R L Jones and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, the following resolution was adopted, -

Whereas, The Cawthon State Bank of DeFuniak Springs, Florida, a county depository has more bonds and security deposited with the State Comptroller of the State of Florida, as security than it has funds on hand in the ROAD AND BRIDGE BOND FUNDS.

Therefore, Be it Resolved, that the State Comptroller of the State of Florida is hereby authorized and requested to release securities to the amount of \$40,000.00, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, That when the State Comptroller is advised by the Chairman of the State Road Department that either the Cawthon State Bank or the First National Bank both of DeFuniak Springs, Fla., has more securities than they have funds on hand, that the State Comptroller release securities covering all, except the funds on hand.

The Board discussed at considerable length the estimated amount of revenue to be received during the budget year 1929-1930, whereupon, it was moved by R L Jones and seconded by J J Ward, the following resolution was adopted, -

Resolved that the following schedule of wages be adopted for the current budget year 1929-1930, - Mule and Tractor Driver @ \$3.00 per day, Machine man @ \$3.00 per day, additional allowance of 50¢ per day for use of their car and the county to furnish gas and oil required to transport them to and from their work, Day Labor @ \$1.75 per day, double team and driver @ \$4.00 per day, and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioners be allowed to expend the following amounts per month during the current budget year, - District #1 \$400.00 per month, Dist. #2 \$400.00 per month, Dist. #3 \$175.00 per month, Dist. #4 \$300.00 per month, Dist. #5 \$250.00 per month, and further understood that these items to include all labor, material and supplies.

Report on examination of the records and accounts of the various county officials made by John W. Williams, Assistant State Auditor as of June 30th, 1929, was filed with the Clerk of this Board on August 21st, 1929, as part of the public records of Walton County.

The Clerk was instructed to call the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company's attention to the shortage of ~~HERKINS~~ walter Wooten, Deputy Sheriff, of fine and cost bonds which he collected before his death and did not pay to the Sheriff as required by law.

The Board discusses at length the Britton Lumber Company suit about their taxes on the 1928 assessment roll, and agreed to give it further consideration on Monday, Sept. 2nd, 1929.

The Board then recessed until Monday, September 2nd, A D 1929.
