

SPECIAL MEETING--SATURDAY October 26th, 1929.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in special session on this Saturday, October 26th, 1929, pursuant to call of its Chairman, with the following members present and participating, W I Stinson, Chairman, J J Ward, W "M" Infinger, Angus Green and R L Jones, being all the members of said Board and M T Fountain, Clerk.

The Chairman announced that the meeting was called for the purpose of discussing disposition of all county convicts which has recently been returned to the County by the State Road Department, and after considerable discussion pro and con, upon motion made by Comr. J J Ward, seconded by Comr. Angus Green and duly carried, ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ by unanimous vote, the following resolution was adopted, -

Resolved That the State Comptroller be and he is hereby requested to authorize this Board to transfer the sum of \$3000.00 from "Reserved for Contingencies" to "Feeding and care of Convicts on Roads" and to be expended for the last named item in the General Road & Bridge Fund of the County. And further resolved, that with the approval of this resolution that the Clerk of this Board be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make the proper entries in the record of his office, and

Further Resolved that W I Stinson, is hereby authorized to secure by proper lease or otherwise a suitable location for a county prison and to proceed to secure material and have erected a county prison for county ~~prisonXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ road work to construct said prison partly by prison labor to secure furnishings for said prison and to do any and everything necessary to place in operation a county prison camp.

Confederate Pension Claim of Charles E. Howell, former member of Home Guard, Comrads George Nichols and Geo. W Stanley, was approved as required by law. The Board then adjourned.
