

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in regular adjourned session on this Thursday, October 31st, A D 1929, pursuant to adjournment of October 8th, 1929, with the following members present and participating, - W I Stinson, Chairman, Angus Green, JJ Ward, R L Jones and W M Infinger, being all the members of said Board and M T Fountain, Clerk.

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, then examined and compared the assessment rolls for the year A D 1929, and finding same correct in so far as they were able to determine, upon motion of Commissioner Angus Green, seconded by Commissioner R L Jones and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members present, ordered that the assessment rolls be accepted and a copy delivered to the Tax Collector, the Tax Collector was instructed not to allow any exemptions from said roll whether noted or not noted thereon except those exemption allowed under Section 897 Compiled General Statutes of Florida, and when allowing exemption under this Statute to require from the person to whom the allowance is made an affidavit covering the facts as required under the Statute, and further ordered that the following orders, affidavits and warrants be recorded in the Minutes of this Board as now provided by law.-

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THE STATE OF FLORIDA, To Hon. W. T. Ray, Tax Collector of the County of Walton.

You are hereby commanded to collect out of the real estate and personal property, and from each of the persons and corporations named in the annexed roll, the taxes set down in each roll opposite each name, corporation or parcel of land therein described, and in case taxes so imposed are not paid at the time prescribed, by law, you are to collect the same by levy and sale of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements so assessed, or of the person or corporation so taxed; and all sums collected for the State taxes you are to pay to the State Treasurer at such time as may be required by law, and at the same time you are to pay to the legally qualified

Depository all sums collected for county taxes, district school taxes and other special taxes; and you are further required to make all collections on or before the first Monday in April; and on or before the first Monday in July you will make a final report to and settlement with the Comptroller and County Commissioners.

W M Infinger, voting Nay, ordered that J S Gaston be employed as County Convict Warden @ \$90.00 per month and allowed 45¢ per day per man for feeding county convicts for thirty days, county to furnish all kitchen and cooking utensils.

Comr. J J Ward was authorized and instructed to purchase equipment such as cots, cot pads, blankets and kitchen cooking utensils for the use in equipping a county convict camp.

The Clerk was instructed by the Board to notify Mr Wm W Flournoy, Attorney for G W Byrd that on account of absence of our County Attorney Hon D Stuart Gillis, that Board delayed any action in regard to G W Byrd's claim against the County.

Hon. W. T. Ray, Tax Collector, submitted his Insolvent Report for the year A.D.1928, of errors, insolvences and double assessment, and the Board having carefully examined and compared the same, it was ordered that the same be accepted and approved upon conditions stated in letter from Hon. Ernest Amos, State Comptroller, to W T Ray, Tax Collector, and Tax Collector be given credit for the following amounts, to-wit:-
