Confederate Pension Claim of R L Crawford, Member Home Guard, Comrads George Stanley and George Nichols, was approved as provided by law.

Confederate Pension Claim of Pinkney R Simpler, member Brady's Co. E. Forest Bn, Comrads James S McKinney and Stephen O C Grant, was approved as provided by Law.

Confederate Pension Claim of Robert S Hatcher, member Home Guard, Comrads George Stanley and George Nichols, was approved as provided by law.

Due notice having been given as required by law in the regular issues of the DeFuniak Herald that this Board would receive sealed bids on this day for the purpose of receiving bids for driving piling for bridges at Little Alaqua Creek and Sellars Mill Creek on the Portland-New Home Road, and pursuant to said notice the following bid or proposal was received and considered by said Board,-

The undersigned as bidders, declares that he has carefully examined the annexed form of contract and specifications and agrees to drive the piling at \$7.50 per piling and cut off the piling according to specifications without additional expense to the County. - - - -

Co. be accepted and contract awarded to them upon condition that the Penton-Mathis Const. Co. furnish capsills, that they will furnish drift bolts and put on capsills @ \$7.50 per piling.
