

The Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, Florida, met in regular session on this Wednesday, January 6, 1932, pursuant to adjournment of December 15th, 1931, with the following members present and participating,- L F Cawthon, Chairman, L E Laird, H. Lancaster, J E Bowers and H. Crook, being all the members of said Board and M T Fountain, Clerk.

W. T. Ray, Tax Collector, filed his report of licenses collected for the months of November and December, 1931, showing \$376.00 collected for the State and \$160.00 collected for Walton County, and his report of polls collected for the months of November and December, 1931, showing \$118.00 collected.

County Farm Agent, M. Wilkins and County Home Agent Eloise McGriff, filed their reports for the month of December, which was examined and filed for future reference.

Upon motion of Comr. H. Lancaster, seconded by Comr. J. E. Bowers, and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members of said Board, the following resolution was adopted,-

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Walton County, that the State Road Department be petitioned thru its' member from this District, Hon. H. H. Wells, that said Road Department include in its MAINTENANCE AND BETTERMENT BUDGET for the year 1932, such an amount as will be required to place a SLAG SURFACE on that part of State Road #40, from State Road #1 at DeFuniak Springs to Freeport, which connects with State Road #10, then HARD SURFACE State Road #115, then SLAG SURFACE State Road #60 from State Road #1 at DeFuniak Springs North to Alabama State line, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Road Department be requested to place such an amount in its CONSTRUCTION BUDGET for the year 1932, to complete the construction of State Road #10 from Walton--Okaloosa County line to Freeport, then construct State Road #152 from State Road #10 near Freeport to North side of Choctawhatchee Bay, then construct that part of State Road #152 from South side of Choctawhatchee Bay to Gulf of Mexico, (Walton County now operating a ferry between these contact points), then construct that part of State Road #10 from Freeport to Choctawhatchee River (Washington County line), then construct State Road #88 from near Ponce de Leon to State Road #10, then construct State Road #218 from State Road #1 near Mossy-head to connect with Government Forest Highway, about three miles, this road leading to State Road #10 at Niceville.

Upon motion of Comr. J. E. Bowers, seconded by Comr. H. Lancaster, and duly carried by unanimous vote of all members of said Board, the following resolution was adopted,-

WHEREAS, July 1, 1927, Walton County issued \$1,250,000.00 county wide ROAD AND BRIDGE BONDS, with interest coupons attached drawing 5½% interest, payable semi-annually, and

WHEREAS, principal and interest of said bonds are payable by order of the STATE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, pursuant to an Act of the Legislature of 1929.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Hon. W.V.Knott, State Treasurer as County Treasurer Ex-Officio and the State Board of Administration, be, and they are hereby requested to purchase for retirement any of the bonds maturing on July 1, 1932 at 97½ or better, plus accrued interest, and the bonds maturing on July 1, 1933 at 96.10 or better, plus accrued interest, if, and when the said Hon. W. V. Knott, State Treasurer as County Treasurer Ex-Officio and the State Board of Administration deems we have sufficient funds on hand to retire same and be able to pay current interest.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the desire of this Board to retire all bonds maturing on July 1, 1932, before any bonds of another maturity is retired, always bearing in mind to have enough money on hand to pay current interest charges.

County Officials bonds were examined as required by law, and the Board decided that the sureties were ample at this time.

The Clerk then read the minutes of the meetings of this Board held on December 8th and 15th, 1931, upon motion of Comr. Laird, seconded by Comr. Bowers and duly carried, were ordered approved as read.

Confederate Soldier's Pension Claim of Dennis Lindsey of Argyle, Fla., member of Home Guard Co. A. of Alabama, was approved as required by law, with J W Davis and G. C. Clark as Comrads.
